

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

Measure: HB 3316 - B

Seventy-Sixth Oregon Legislative Assembly – 2011 Regular Session
Legislative Fiscal Office

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Measure Description:

Adds photogrammetric mapping and transportation planning to list of services subject to procurement procedures for contracting with architects, engineers, photogrammetrists, transportation planners and land surveyors. Requires contracting agency to use procedure to select consultant that is based initially only on qualifications of consultant.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Local Governments, Statewide

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

The measure has no fiscal impact on state agencies. Local contracting agencies are currently not required to use a Qualifications Based Selection (QBS) process for the contracting of architectural and engineering services. The measure would require local contracting agencies to use QBS processes for these contracts and as such there may be some unknown increase in total contract costs for those local contracting agencies who use a lowest cost provider selection process currently.
