

# Senate Bill 479

Sponsored by Senator BONAMICI; Senators BATES, DINGFELDER, MONROE (at the request of Rex Brasell and Elinor Gollay) (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires application for driver license to contain information about whether or not applicant wants to make anatomical gift.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to anatomical gifts; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 807.050.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 807.050 is amended to read:

5 807.050. An application for a license shall be in a form approved by the Oregon Department of  
6 Transportation. An application must contain all the following:

7 (1) The applicant's full legal name, age, sex, residence address, except as otherwise provided for  
8 corrections officers in ORS 802.253, eligible employees in ORS 802.250 or Address Confidentiality  
9 Program participants in ORS 192.846, and post-office address other than general delivery. The de-  
10 partment may provide by rule for acceptance of something other than an actual residence or post-  
11 office address if the department determines that the applicant does not have an actual address. The  
12 department shall require proof to verify the address in addition to anything else the department may  
13 require of the applicant.

14 (2) Whether or not the applicant has ever been issued any driver license or driver permit. If the  
15 applicant has been issued any license or driver permit:

16 (a) When the license or driver permit was granted;

17 (b) What jurisdiction granted the license or driver permit;

18 (c) Whether or not the driving privileges under the license or driver permit are currently sus-  
19 pended or revoked; and

20 (d) If the driving privileges are revoked or suspended, the date and reason for the suspension  
21 or revocation.

22 (3) The class of license sought.

23 (4) The Social Security number of the applicant or other number or identifying information de-  
24 termined appropriate by the Secretary of the United States Department of Transportation, if the  
25 application is for a commercial driver license or if the Oregon Department of Transportation by rule  
26 requires the Social Security number on the application.

27 **(5) Whether or not the applicant wants to make an anatomical gift, as defined in ORS**  
28 **97.953.**

29 [(5)] (6) Any other information the department deems necessary to assist the department in de-  
30 termining whether the applicant is qualified or eligible to be licensed.

31 **SECTION 2.** The amendments to ORS 807.050 by section 1 of this 2011 Act apply to ap-
