

**SENATE AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 4063
(INCLUDING AMENDMENTS TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS)**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 5, after "807.040;" insert "repealing sections 3
2 and 7, chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2012 (Enrolled House Bill 4008);".

3 On page 2, line 24, delete the period and insert "; or".

4 In line 25, after "States" insert ", if the applicant provides the commission with documentation
5 of military training or experience that the commission determines is substantially equivalent to the
6 training required for an initial or basic teaching license".

7 On page 9, after line 11, insert:

8 **"SECTION 17a. If House Bill 4008 becomes law, sections 16 and 17 of this 2012 Act (both
9 amending ORS 688.455) are repealed.**

10 **"SECTION 17b.** If House Bill 4008 becomes law, ORS 688.455, as amended by section 7, chapter
11 833, Oregon Laws 2009, and section 2, chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2012 (Enrolled House Bill 4008),
12 is amended to read:

13 "688.455. (1) The Board of Medical Imaging shall issue a license to a person to practice a med-
14 ical imaging modality if the person makes an application in writing and pays a fee in an amount
15 established by the board and if the person, at the time of application:

16 "(a) Is at least 18 years of age;

17 "(b) Satisfies one of the following requirements:

18 "(A) Has graduated from an approved school;

19 "(B) No later than December 31, 2010, passed the examination of the American Registry of
20 Radiologic Technologists after being sponsored for the examination by the State of Oregon;

21 "(C) Was initially licensed by the Board of Radiologic Technology before 1980 and held an active
22 license from the Board of Medical Imaging on July 1, 2010; or

23 "(D) Meets the requirements for licensing under ORS 688.495;

24 "(c) Has undergone a background check to the satisfaction of the board as established in rules
25 adopted by the board;

26 "(d) Has not had a license of any type revoked by this state or any state, territory of the United
27 States or nation;

28 "(e) Has not had a credential revoked by any credentialing organization; and

29 "(f) Meets the standards of ethical conduct established in the professional standards of the cor-
30 responding credentialing organization or a medical imaging modality's professional society.

31 "(2) All applicants for a license are subject to the examination policies of their respective cre-
32 dentialing organizations.

33 **"(3) An applicant meets the requirements of subsection (1)(b)(A) of this section if the
34 applicant provides the board with documentation of military training or experience that the**

1 **board determines is substantially equivalent to the education required by subsection (1)(b)(A)**
2 **of this section.**

3 “[*(3)(a)*] (4)(a) The board may consider issuing a new license to a person whose revoked cre-
4 dential has been reinstated by a credentialing organization or whose license of any type has been
5 reinstated by another state.

6 “(b) The board shall consider issuing a new license under this subsection on a case by case basis
7 and shall adopt rules governing issuance of a new license.

8 **“SECTION 17c. If House Bill 4008 becomes law, sections 3 (amending ORS 688.455) and**
9 **7, chapter __, Oregon Laws 2012 (Enrolled House Bill 4008), are repealed and ORS 688.455,**
10 **as amended by section 7, chapter 833, Oregon Laws 2009, section 2, chapter __, Oregon Laws**
11 **2012 (Enrolled House Bill 4008), and section 17b of this 2012 Act, is amended to read:**

12 “688.455. (1) The Board of Medical Imaging shall issue a license to a person to practice a med-
13 ical imaging modality if the person makes an application in writing and pays a fee in an amount
14 established by the board and if the person, at the time of application:

15 “(a) Is at least 18 years of age;

16 “(b) Satisfies one of the following requirements:

17 “[*(A)*] *Has graduated from an approved school;*

18 **“(A) Holds a credential issued by a credentialing organization in a medical imaging**
19 **modality recognized by the board or provides the board with documentation of military**
20 **training or experience that the board determines is substantially equivalent to the creden-**
21 **tialing requirements;**

22 **“(B) No later than December 31, 2010, passed the examination of the American Registry of**
23 **Radiologic Technologists after being sponsored for the examination by the State of Oregon;**

24 **“(C) Was initially licensed by the Board of Radiologic Technology before 1980 and held an active**
25 **license from the Board of Medical Imaging on July 1, 2010; or**

26 **“(D) Meets the requirements for licensing under ORS 688.495;**

27 **“(c) Has undergone a background check to the satisfaction of the board as established in rules**
28 **adopted by the board;**

29 **“(d) Has not had a license of any type revoked by this state or any state, territory of the United**
30 **States or nation;**

31 **“(e) Has not had a credential revoked by any credentialing organization; and**

32 **“(f) Meets the standards of ethical conduct established in the professional standards of the cor-**
33 **responding credentialing organization or a medical imaging modality’s professional society.**

34 **“(2) All applicants for a license are subject to the examination policies of their respective cre-**
35 **credentialing organizations.**

36 *“(3) An applicant meets the requirements of subsection (1)(b)(A) of this section if the applicant*
37 *provides the board with documentation of military training or experience that the board determines is*
38 *substantially equivalent to the education required by subsection (1)(b)(A) of this section.]*

39 “[*(4)(a)*] (3)(a) The board may consider issuing a new license to a person whose revoked cre-
40 dential has been reinstated by a credentialing organization or whose license of any type has been
41 reinstated by another state.

42 “(b) The board shall consider issuing a new license under this subsection on a case by case basis
43 and shall adopt rules governing issuance of a new license.”.

44 On page 17, after line 5, insert:

45 **“SECTION 32. The amendments to ORS 688.455 by section 17c of this 2012 Act become**

1 **operative on January 1, 2014.”.**

2 In line 6, delete “32” and insert “33”.

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
