Telehealth reimbursement workgroup proposed legislation that changes reimbursement for telemed services requirements for health benefit plans.

LC 1103 – relating to advance directives

Proposed updates and simplification to Oregon's Advanced Care Directive statutes

LC 1472 – relating to definition of small employer

Aligns small employer definition with federal definition

LC 1473 – relating to small employers

Allows out-of-state employees of an in-state employer to be included in the definition of small employer

LC 1846 – relating to State Board of Pharmacy

Modifies BoP membership; deletes public member position and adds licensed pharmacy technician

LC 1871 – relating to independent living options for children in state custody

Expands current requirements to allow foster youth to have access to the Independent Living Program services

LC 1872 – relating to extracurricular activities for foster youth

Directs DHS to adopt rules to allow foster children the opportunity to participate in a minimum of one extracurricular activity

LC 1965 – relating to payment for telemedical health services

Modifies telemedical health services definition and requirements for health benefit plan coverage of telemedical services

LC 1969 – relating to the practice of optometry

Grants authority to optometrists to prescribe Schedule II hydrocodone-combination drugs

LC 2397 – relating to reimbursement of primary care services

Placeholder for the HB 2902 Task Force – Primary and Mental Health Care Reimbursement Task Force

LC 2767 – relating to procurement authority for the Oregon Health Authority

Requires OHA to exercise procurement authority under Public Contracting Code and under supervision of DAS.
