Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2607
Modifies method of determining amount of presentence incarceration credits for persons convicted of crime.
- HB 2836 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Establishes standards and procedures for determining fitness of youth to proceed on delinquency petition.
- HB 3463 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Directs Public Defense Services Commission to adopt policies and negotiate contract that provide for compensation of appointed counsel at rate equivalent to assistant or deputy district attorney of comparable experience practicing within same county as appointed counsel.
- HB 3467
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Requires individual seeking disclosure of photographic records of arrested person from law enforcement agency to submit written request to agency, in person and with payment of fees.

Work Session

- HB 2685
Authorizes temporary release of inmates conveyed to another jurisdiction on same terms as inmates confined in Department of Corrections institution.
- HB 2710
Provides that drone may be used by law enforcement agency for purpose of surveillance of person only pursuant to warrant or in emergency circumstances.
- HB 2963
Provides that state law may not be construed implicitly to preempt city's authority to control or regulate use of sidewalks.
- HB 3249 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Department of Human Services to exercise due diligence to identify and locate grandparent of ward in department's custody and to give grandparent notice of hearings concerning ward.
- HB 3363
Requires Department of Human Services to disclose case plan and written information to court appointed special advocate in juvenile dependency proceedings.
