Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 42 A
Creates process for appeal from circuit court's granting or denying DNA test, granting or denying motion for new trial and denying appointment of counsel.
- SB 44 A
Directs appellate court to notify parties to appeal when appellate court receives corrected or supplemental judgment from trial court.
- SB 697
Prohibits person not licensed to perform tattooing from possessing equipment used for tattooing with intent to use that equipment on another person.
