- HB 2049  
Authorizes juvenile community supervision officer to take youth offender who violates parole into custody upon issuance of order or warrant of arrest.
- HB 2607 A  
Modifies method of determining amount of presentence incarceration credits for persons convicted of crime.
- HB 2774 \*\*  
Repeals sunset on Task Force on Victims' Rights Enforcement. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2920  
Amends statements required for notice of criminal offender record check in investigations of child abuse or neglect.
- HB 3183 A  
Authorizes county sheriff to deliver person sentenced to custody of Department of Corrections directly to youth correction facility if person is under 20 years of age at time of sentencing and was under 18 years of age at time of offense.
- HB 3363 A  
Requires Department of Human Services to disclose case plan and written information to all parties in juvenile dependency proceedings.

#### Work Session

- HB 2205 A  
Adds members of Legislative Assembly, attorneys, dentists, optometrists and chiropractors to list of public or private officials required to report abuse of person 65 years of age or older, operative January 1, 2015.
