Measure Description:

Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study on freezing tuition increases for incoming undergraduate students at public universities.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, Oregon Educational Investment Board, Higher Education Coordinating Commission, Oregon University System (OUS)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Higher Education and Workforce Development to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill proposes a pilot program to replace the current system of tuition and fees. The agencies anticipate having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
