

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2656

1 On page 6 of the printed bill, delete line 9 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 14. (1) For the two-year period beginning on the effective date of this 2013 Act,**  
3 **moneys described in subsection (2) of this section shall be used by the Oregon Tourism**  
4 **Commission, in consultation with the Governor’s Office of Film and Television, to promote**  
5 **tourism in rural areas in Oregon through film and video. Moneys may be used under this**  
6 **subsection for reasonable travel expenses related to the production of film and video to**  
7 **promote tourism in rural areas in Oregon.**

8 **“(2) Subsection (1) of this section applies to the greater of:**

9 **“(a) Amounts of state transient lodging taxes that would not have been collected but for**  
10 **the enhanced administration and enforcement of existing transient lodging tax law effected**  
11 **by the amendments to ORS 320.300, 320.305, 320.310, 320.315, 320.320, 320.325 and 320.330 by**  
12 **sections 3 to 9 of this 2013 Act, after payment of refunds and reimbursement of the Depart-**  
13 **ment of Revenue pursuant to ORS 320.335; or**

14 **“(b) \$600,000.**

15 **“(3) Not later than December 1, 2015, the commission shall submit a report, in the man-**  
16 **ner provided in ORS 192.245, to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to**  
17 **economic development detailing the commission’s activities pursuant to this section.**

18 **“(4) As used in this section, ‘rural area’ means an area located entirely outside the ac-**  
19 **knowledged Portland Metropolitan Area Regional Urban Growth Boundary and the acknowl-**  
20 **edged urban growth boundaries of cities with populations of 100,000 or more.**

21 **“SECTION 15. (1) Section 2 of this 2013 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.**

22 **“(2) Section 14 of this 2013 Act is repealed on January 2, 2017.”.**

23 In line 10, delete “15” and insert “16”.
