

**SENATE AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2668  
(INCLUDING AMENDMENTS TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS)**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, delete “amending ORS” and insert “creating new provisions; and  
2 amending ORS 346.680 and”.

3 In line 5, delete “exclusion” and insert “exclusions”.

4 Delete lines 13 and 14 and insert:

5 “(2) A place of public accommodation does not include:

6 “(a) A Department of Corrections institution as defined in ORS 421.005.

7 “(b) A state hospital as defined in ORS 162.135.

8 “(c) A youth correction facility as defined in ORS 420.005.

9 “(d) A local correction facility or lockup as defined in ORS 169.005.

10 “(e) An institution, bona fide club or place of accommodation that is in its nature distinctly  
11 private.

12 “**SECTION 2.** ORS 346.680 is amended to read:

13 “346.680. As used in ORS 346.680 to 346.690:

14 “(1) ‘Assistance animal’ means any animal trained to assist a person with a physical impairment  
15 in one or more daily life activities, including but not limited to:

16 “(a) Dog guides, as defined in ORS 346.610;

17 “(b) Hearing ear dogs, as defined in ORS 346.640;

18 “(c) An animal trained to pull a wheelchair;

19 “(d) An animal trained to fetch dropped items; and

20 “(e) An animal trained to perform balance work.

21 “(2) ‘Assistance animal trainee’ means any animal undergoing training to assist a person with  
22 a physical impairment.

23 “(3) ‘Daily life activity’ includes but is not limited to:

24 “(a) Self-care;

25 “(b) Ambulation;

26 “(c) Communication; or

27 “(d) Transportation.

28 “(4) ‘Mode of transportation’ means any mode of transportation operating within this state.

29 “(5) ‘Person with a physical impairment’ means any person who has a permanent physical  
30 impairment, whose physical impairment limits one or more of daily life activities and who has a re-  
31 cord of impairment and is regarded by health care practitioners as having such an impairment, re-  
32 quiring the use of an assistance animal including but not limited to blindness, deafness and complete  
33 or partial paralysis.

34 “(6) ‘Public accommodation’ means a place of public accommodation as defined in ORS 659A.400

1 including but not limited to educational institutions, airlines and restaurants. The [*exception*] **ex-**  
2 **clusions** stated in ORS 659A.400 (2) [*is not an exception*] **are not exclusions** under ORS 90.390 and  
3 346.680 to 346.690.

4 **“SECTION 3. If Senate Bill 610 becomes law, section 2 of this 2013 Act (amending ORS**  
5 **346.680) is repealed.”.**
