

## SENATE MINORITY REPORT AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1556

By Nonconcurring Members of COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the semicolon delete the rest of the line and line 3  
2 and insert “amending ORS 475.314.”.

3 Delete lines 5 through 28 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 “**SECTION 1.** ORS 475.314 is amended to read:

5 “475.314. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall establish by rule a medical marijuana facility  
6 registration system to authorize the transfer of usable marijuana and immature marijuana plants  
7 from:

8 “(a) A registry identification cardholder, the designated primary caregiver of a registry iden-  
9 tification cardholder, or a person responsible for a marijuana grow site to the medical marijuana  
10 facility; or

11 “(b) A medical marijuana facility to a registry identification cardholder or the designated pri-  
12 mary caregiver of a registry identification cardholder.

13 “(2) The registration system established under subsection (1) of this section must require a  
14 medical marijuana facility to submit an application to the authority that includes:

15 “(a) The name of the person responsible for the medical marijuana facility;

16 “(b) The address of the medical marijuana facility;

17 “(c) Proof that the person responsible for the medical marijuana facility is a resident of Oregon;

18 “(d) Documentation, as required by the authority by rule, that demonstrates the medical  
19 marijuana facility meets the qualifications for a medical marijuana facility as described in sub-  
20 section (3) of this section; and

21 “(e) Any other information that the authority considers necessary.

22 “(3) To qualify for registration under this section, a medical marijuana facility:

23 “(a) Must be located in an area that is zoned for commercial, industrial or mixed use or as ag-  
24 ricultural land; *[and]*

25 “(b) May not be located at the same address as a marijuana grow site;

26 “[*b*] (c) Must be registered as a business or have filed a pending application to register as a  
27 business with the Office of the Secretary of State;

28 “[*c*] (d) Must not be located within 1,000 feet of the real property comprising a **public or**  
29 **private preschool or** a public or private elementary, secondary or career school attended primarily  
30 by minors;

31 “[*d*] (e) Must not be located within 1,000 feet of another medical marijuana facility; and

32 “[*e*] (f) Must comport with rules adopted by the authority related to:

33 “(A) Installing a minimum security system, including a video surveillance system, alarm system  
34 and safe; and

1 “(B) Testing for pesticides, mold and mildew and the processes by which usable marijuana and  
2 immature marijuana plants that test positive for pesticides, mold or mildew must be returned to the  
3 registry identification cardholder, the cardholder’s designated primary caregiver or the cardholder’s  
4 registered grower.

5 “(4)(a) The authority shall conduct a criminal records check under ORS 181.534 of a person  
6 whose name is submitted as the person responsible for a medical marijuana facility under subsection  
7 (2) of this section.

8 “(b) A person convicted for the manufacture or delivery of a controlled substance in Schedule  
9 I or Schedule II may not be the person responsible for a medical marijuana facility for five years  
10 from the date the person is convicted.

11 “(c) A person convicted more than once for the manufacture or delivery of a controlled sub-  
12 stance in Schedule I or Schedule II may not be the person responsible for a medical marijuana fa-  
13 cility.

14 “(5) If a person submits the application required under subsection (2) of this section, the medical  
15 marijuana facility identified in the application meets the qualifications for a medical marijuana fa-  
16 cility described in subsection (3) of this section and the person responsible for the medical marijuana  
17 facility passes the criminal records check required under subsection (4) of this section, the authority  
18 shall register the medical marijuana facility and issue the person responsible for the medical  
19 marijuana facility proof of registration. The person responsible for the medical marijuana facility  
20 shall display the proof of registration on the premises of the medical marijuana facility at all times  
21 when usable marijuana or immature marijuana plants are being transferred as described in sub-  
22 section (1) of this section.

23 “(6)(a) A registered medical marijuana facility may receive usable marijuana or immature  
24 marijuana plants only from a registry identification cardholder, designated primary caregiver or  
25 person responsible for a marijuana grow site if the registered medical marijuana facility obtains  
26 authorization, on a form prescribed by the authority by rule and signed by a registry identification  
27 cardholder, to receive the usable marijuana or immature marijuana plants.

28 “(b) A registered medical marijuana facility shall maintain:

29 “(A) A copy of each authorization form described in paragraph (a) of this subsection; and

30 “(B) Documentation of each transfer of usable marijuana or immature marijuana plants.

31 “(7) A medical marijuana facility registered under this section may possess usable marijuana and  
32 immature marijuana plants in excess of the limits imposed on registry identification cardholders and  
33 designated primary caregivers under ORS 475.320.

34 “(8)(a) **A registered medical marijuana facility may not transfer any**  
35 **tetrahydrocannabinol-infused product that is meant to be swallowed or inhaled, unless the**  
36 **product:**

37 “(A) **Is packaged in child-resistant safety packaging that meets standards established by**  
38 **the authority by rule;**

39 “(B) **Is packaged in plastic that is four millimeters or greater in thickness, is heat sealed**  
40 **and has no tab, dimple, corner or flap that makes opening the package easier; or**

41 “(C) **If in liquid form, is bottled and sealed with a metal crown cork bottle cap.**

42 “(b) **A registered medical marijuana facility may not transfer any tetrahydrocannabinol-**  
43 **infused product that is manufactured or packaged in a manner that is attractive to minors,**  
44 **as determined by the authority by rule.**

45 “[8] (9) The authority may inspect:

1       “(a) The premises of an applicant for a medical marijuana facility or a registered medical  
 2 marijuana facility to ensure compliance with the qualifications for a medical marijuana facility de-  
 3 scribed in subsection (3) of this section; and

4       “(b) The records of a registered medical marijuana facility to ensure compliance with subsection  
 5 (6)(b) of this section.

6       “[(9)(a)] (10)(a) A registry identification cardholder or the designated primary caregiver of a  
 7 registry identification cardholder may reimburse a medical marijuana facility registered under this  
 8 section for the normal and customary costs of doing business, including costs related to transferring,  
 9 handling, securing, insuring, testing, packaging and processing usable marijuana and immature  
 10 marijuana plants and the cost of supplies, utilities and rent or mortgage.

11       “(b) A medical marijuana facility may reimburse a person responsible for a marijuana grow site  
 12 under this section for the normal and customary costs of doing business, including costs related to  
 13 transferring, handling, securing, insuring, testing, packaging and processing usable marijuana and  
 14 immature marijuana plants and the cost of supplies, utilities and rent or mortgage.

15       “[(10)] (11) The authority may revoke the registration of a medical marijuana facility registered  
 16 under this section for failure to comply with ORS 475.300 to 475.346 or rules adopted under ORS  
 17 475.300 to 475.346. The authority may release to the public a final order revoking a medical  
 18 marijuana facility registration.

19       “[(11)] (12)(a) The authority shall adopt rules to implement this section, including rules that:

20       “[(a)] (A) Require a medical marijuana facility registered under this section to annually renew  
 21 that registration; and

22       “[(b)] (B) Establish fees for registering and renewing registration for a medical marijuana fa-  
 23 cility under this section.

24       “(b) In adopting rules under subsection (8)(a)(A) of this section, the authority shall con-  
 25 sider standards established under and pursuant to the federal Poison Prevention Packaging  
 26 Act.”.
