SB 369  
Enacts Uniform Fiduciary Access to Digital Assets Act.

#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 344  
Decreases penalty for crime of cheating to maximum of one year's imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both.  
*For the purpose of consideration of amendments.*
- SB 349  
Repeals obsolete provision relating to jury trials in county courts.  
*For the purpose of consideration of amendments.*
- SB 352  
Increases time for conducting preliminary hearing on minor's application for emancipation to 15 days after date of filing.  
*For the purpose of consideration of amendments.*
- SB 353  
Increases statute of limitations from 10 to 12 years for causes of action with no specified statute of limitations.  
*For the purpose of consideration of amendments.*
- SB 392  
Directs Department of Justice to conduct study on domestic violence criminal statutes and present report on findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before September 15, 2016.  
*For the purpose of consideration of amendments.*
- SB 528  
Provides persons licensed to carry concealed handgun in another state with protections provided to persons with Oregon concealed handgun license.  
*For the purpose of consideration of amendments.*
