

Please remove the language about needing the information on the firearms being bought (make, model and serial number), as well as the requirement to keep the information for a minimum of 5 years.

There is no reason to have any record-keeping of this kind in the bill and makes it more of a gun registration scheme instead of the background check bill that it's supposed to be.

Gun owners like myself are not 100% opposed to background checks, but ARE strictly opposed to any form of gun registrations that serve no other point but to set this state up for future bans on weapons.
