

This bill will not stop criminals from getting weapons. They are criminals. They do not obey laws because they are criminals. They will and do get weapons from other criminals. Criminals do not do background checks.

Law abiding citizens do not sell/give weapons to criminals.

This law will only impact law abiding citizens and will not resolve the issues it was intended to fix.

The only way this law could be enforced is if there is a registry of who owns what weapons. Oregon does not have a requirement to keep such a registry. And then the only way you could know if someone broke the law is if you started a confiscation. Although it does not state it directly, this registry is hinted at all over this bill.

Both a registry and confiscation is against Oregon and federal constitution.

Please do not vote for a law that will not work as intended. Enforce the laws as written already on the books would have a much bigger impact towards the intended goal than adding another unenforceable law.
