- 57 FAA funded airports (NIPIAS) 10% - 90%
- 28 owned by State of Oregon-Dept of Aviation
- 12,000 jobs in 78 towns
- \$62,395 average wage
- \$22 Billion economic impact

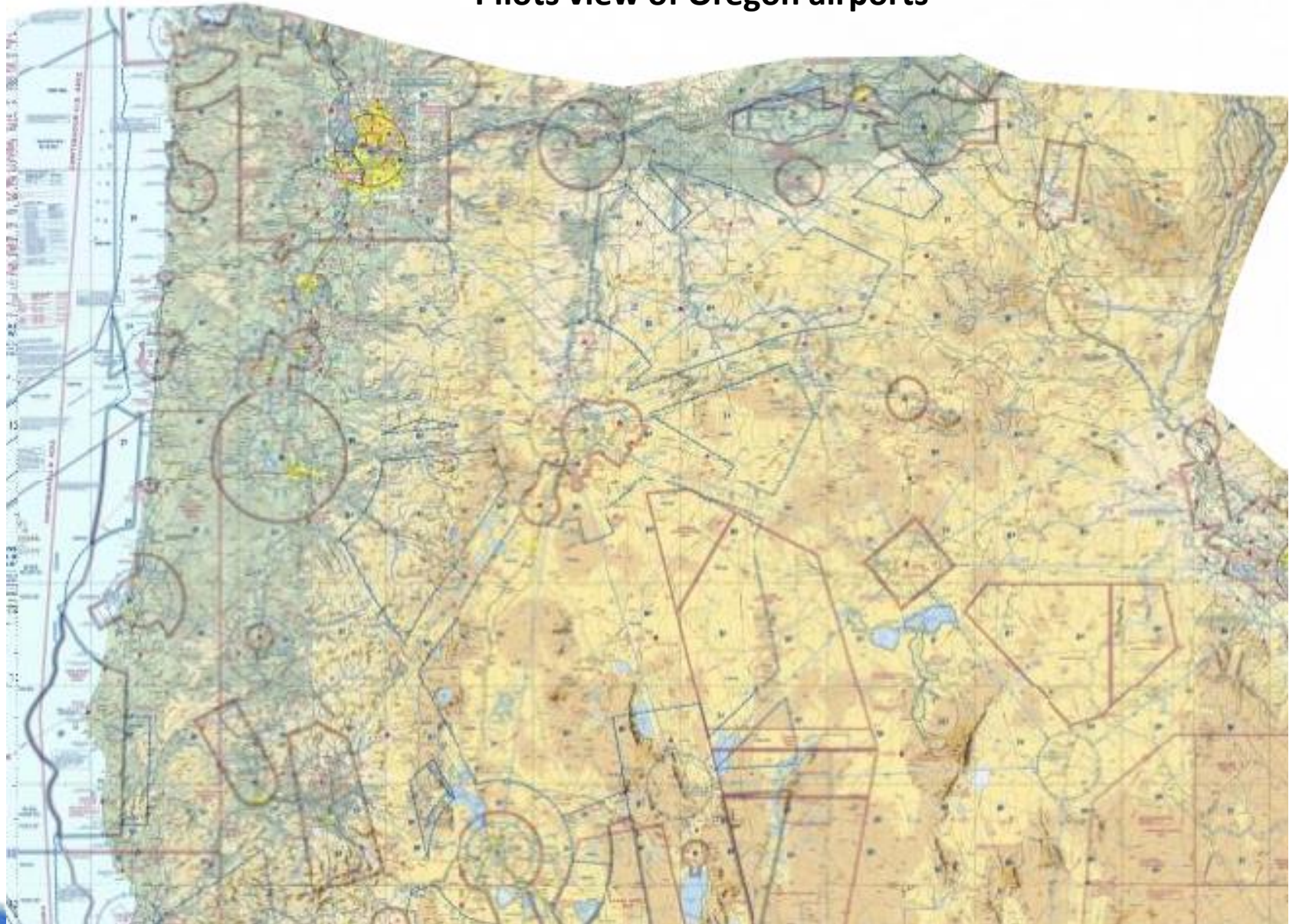

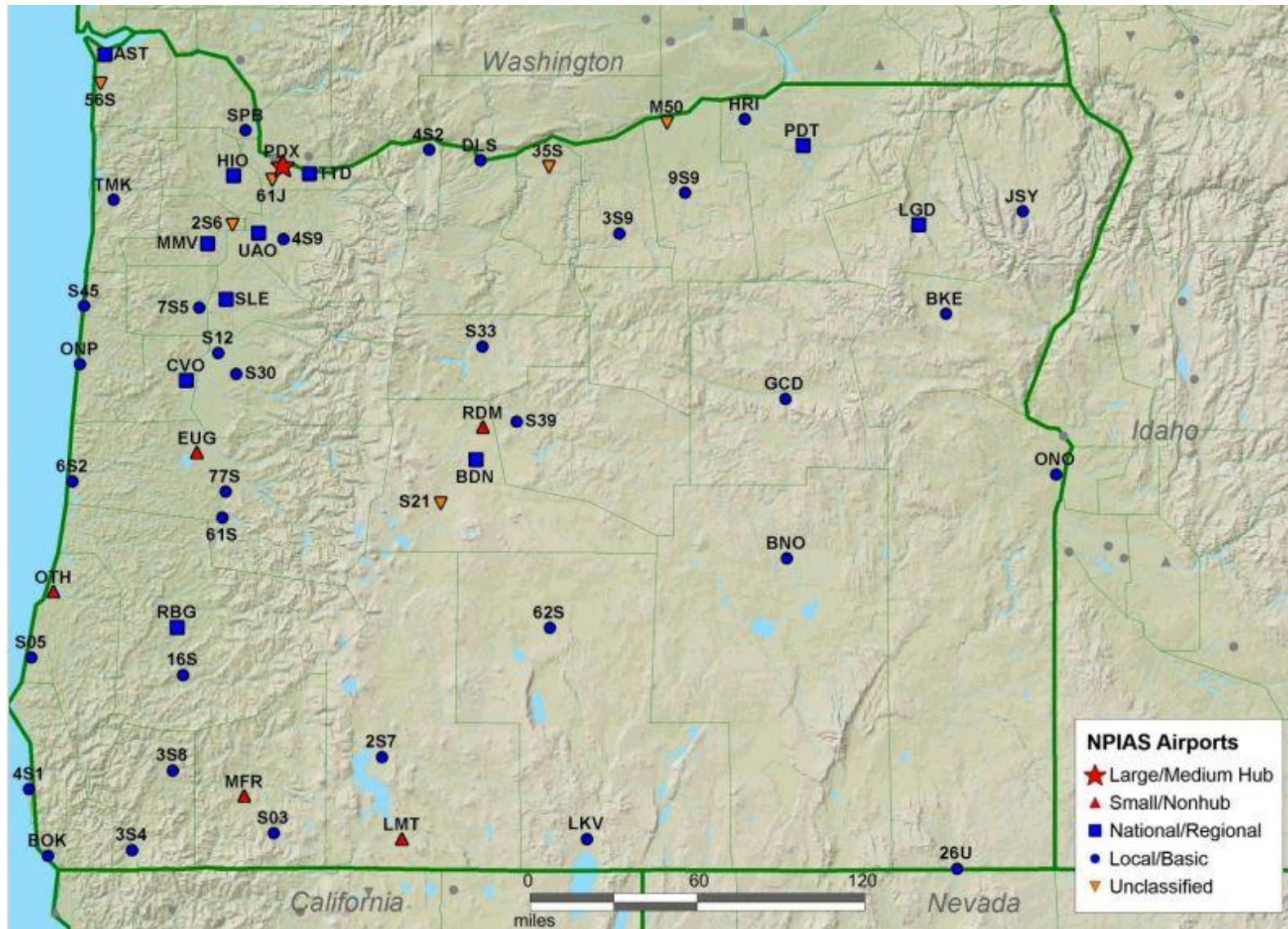
# Pilots view of Oregon airports
