SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires Director of Oregon State Lottery to provide information about lottery prize recipient to Department of Human Services within seven days after paying lottery prize of ~~[\$1,000]~~ **\$1,250** or more.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to public benefits of lottery prize winners; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 461.

SECTION 2. For the purpose of complying with section 4009 of the Agricultural Act of 2014, P.L. 113-79, within seven days after paying a prize of \$1,250 or more, the Director of the Oregon State Lottery shall notify the Department of Human Services of the name of the prize recipient, the Social Security number of the recipient, any other available identifying information about the recipient and the amount of the prize paid to the recipient.

SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2015 Act applies to lottery prizes paid on or after the effective date of this 2015 Act.

SECTION 4. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.
