

**SENATE AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2704**

1 On page 2 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 17 and 18 and insert:

2 “(b) A person who records a conversation in which a law enforcement officer is a participant,
3 if:

4 “(A) The recording is made while the officer is performing official duties;

5 “(B) The recording is made openly and in plain view of the participants in the conversation;

6 “(C) The conversation being recorded is audible to the person by normal unaided hearing; and

7 “(D) The person is in a place where the person lawfully may be;”.

8 After line 43, insert:

9 “(9) The exception described in subsection (5)(b) of this section does not authorize the person
10 recording the law enforcement officer to engage in criminal trespass as described in ORS 164.243,
11 164.245, 164.255, 164.265 or 164.278 or to interfere with a peace officer as described in ORS
12 162.247.”.

13 In line 44, delete “(9)” and insert “(10)”.
