

House Bill 3257

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Extends sunset on collection of certain moneys from electric companies or Oregon Community Power for purposes related to low-income electric bill payment assistance.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to low-income electric bill payment assistance; amending section 4, chapter 566, Oregon
3 Laws 2011; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 4, chapter 566, Oregon Laws 2011, as amended by section 2, chapter 254,
6 Oregon Laws 2013, is amended to read:

7 **Sec. 4.** Section 3, chapter 566, Oregon Laws 2011, is repealed on January 2, [2016] **2018**.

8 **SECTION 2.** **This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
9 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
10 **on its passage.**
