

House Bill 3350

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON HEALTH CARE

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Education to prepare statement that discloses potential health risks of wireless technology.

Requires public and private schools to distribute statement to employees and parents of students.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to health risk disclosures in school; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Education shall:

(a) Prepare a statement that discloses the potential health risks of wireless technology; and

(b) Make the statement described in paragraph (a) of this subsection available for distribution by public and private elementary and secondary schools of this state.

(2) Each school district must annually distribute the statement prepared under subsection (1) of this section to the employees of the school district and to the parents of the students of the school district.

(3) Each private school in this state with students in any grade from kindergarten through grade 12 must annually distribute the statement prepared under subsection (1) of this section to the employees of the school and to the parents of the students of the school.

SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect July 1, 2015.
