Corrected Summary

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to [*determine definitions for employee categories at post-secondary institutions of education*] **convene work group of stakeholders to determine most appropriate method for public universities and community colleges to report employment data for employees.**

[*Requires each community college and public university to report to commission relevant staffing ratios for each employee category.*]

Sunsets work group June 30, 2017.

Requires commission to **use data from national post-secondary data collection system within United States Department of Education to report** [*relevant*] **staffing ratios of faculty and staff at public universities and community colleges** to Legislative Assembly.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to higher education employees; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall convene a work**
5 **group of stakeholders to determine the most appropriate method for public universities listed**
6 **in ORS 352.002 and community colleges to report relevant employment data in a consistent**
7 **and detailed manner for the following categories of employees:**

8 (a) **Full-time faculty;**

9 (b) **Part-time faculty;**

10 (c) **Graduate faculty;**

11 (d) **Full-time classified employees;**

12 (e) **Part-time classified employees;**

13 (f) **Full-time nonteaching professional staff;**

14 (g) **Part-time nonteaching professional staff;**

15 (h) **Full-time supervisory employees;**

16 (i) **Part-time supervisory employees;**

17 (j) **Full-time management staff; and**

18 (k) **Part-time management staff.**

19 (2) **The work group's determinations under this section must include recommendations**
20 **regarding when and how often the public universities listed in ORS 352.002 and community**
21 **colleges should provide the relevant employment data to the commission, and when and how**
22 **often the commission should provide the data to the Legislative Assembly.**

23 (3) **The commission shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245 detailing**

1 the determinations reached under this section to the interim legislative committees on
2 higher education no later than December 1, 2016.

3 **SECTION 2.** Section 1 of this 2015 Act is repealed on June 30, 2017.

4 **SECTION 3.** (1) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall use data available
5 from a national post-secondary data collection system within the United States Department
6 of Education to compile a report that details the number of faculty and staff at each public
7 university listed in ORS 352.002 and at each community college.

8 (2) The report required under subsection (1) of this section must:

9 (a) Cover each academic year from the 2010-2011 academic year onward; and

10 (b) Provide the number of faculty and staff for each category of employee that is avail-
11 able at the national post-secondary data collection system used by the commission under
12 subsection (1) of this section.

13 (3) The commission shall submit the report required under subsection (1) of this section
14 to the interim legislative committees on higher education no later than December 1, 2015.

15 **SECTION 4.** Section 3 of this 2015 Act is repealed on June 30, 2016.

16 **SECTION 5.** This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
17 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect
18 on its passage.
