

# Senate Bill 173

Sponsored by Senator BOQUIST (at the request of Kevin M. Hall) (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes person licensed to carry concealed handgun to present valid license instead of providing firearm to peace officer for examination when possessing firearm in public building.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to firearms in public buildings; amending ORS 166.380.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 166.380 is amended to read:

5 166.380. (1) **Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section**, a peace officer may examine  
6 a firearm possessed by anyone on the person while in or on a public building to determine whether  
7 the firearm is a loaded firearm.

8 **(2) A person who is licensed under ORS 166.291 and 166.292 to carry a concealed handgun**  
9 **may present a valid concealed handgun license to the peace officer instead of providing the**  
10 **firearm to the peace officer for examination.**

11 [(2)] **(3) Refusal by a person to allow the examination as authorized by subsection (1) of this**  
12 **section and the failure to present a valid concealed handgun license as authorized by sub-**  
13 **section (2) of this section** constitutes reason to believe that the person has committed a crime and  
14 the peace officer may make an arrest pursuant to ORS 133.310.
