

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 385

- 1       On page 1 of the printed bill, line 11, delete the boldfaced material.
- 2       In line 15, after “Court” delete the rest of the line and insert “, a municipal court, a probate  
3 court or a juvenile court or a justice of the peace.”
- 4       After line 17, insert:
- 5       “(5) ‘Juvenile court’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 419A.004.”
- 6       In line 18, delete “(5)” and insert “(6)”.
- 7       After line 23, insert:
- 8       “(7) ‘Local court facility’ means the portion of a building in which a justice court, a municipal  
9 court, a probate court or a juvenile court conducts business, during the hours in which the court  
10 operates.
- 11       “(8) ‘Probate court’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 111.005.”
- 12       In line 24, delete “(6)” and insert “(9)”.
- 13       On page 2, line 1, delete “(7)” and insert “(10)”.
- 14       After line 23, insert:
- 15       “(C) A firearm in a local court facility is guilty, upon conviction, of a Class C felony if, prior  
16 to the offense, the presiding judge of the local court facility entered an order prohibiting firearms  
17 in the area in which the court conducts business and during the hours in which the court  
18 operates.”
- 19       After line 25, insert:
- 20       “(c) Within a shared court facility, the presiding judge of a municipal court or justice of the  
21 peace district may not enter an order concerning the possession of weapons in the court facility that  
22 is in conflict with an order entered by the presiding judge of the circuit court.”
- 23       On page 3, delete lines 29 through 31 and insert:
- 24       “(a) The procedures for a circuit court must be established through a plan for court security  
25 improvement, emergency preparedness and business continuity under ORS 1.177 or 1.180;
- 26       “(b) The procedures for a justice court or a municipal court may only prohibit the possession  
27 of weapons within the area in which the court conducts business and during the hours in which the  
28 court operates;
- 29       “(c) Within a shared court facility, the presiding judge of a municipal court or justice of the  
30 peace district may not establish procedures in conflict with the procedures established by the pre-  
31 siding judge of the circuit court; and”.
- 32       In line 32, delete “(b)” and insert “(d)”.
