

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 472

By COMMITTEE ON BUSINESS AND TRANSPORTATION

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, delete “section 2,” and insert “sections 2, 3 and 4.”

2 In line 3, after “2009” insert “; and declaring an emergency”.

3 After line 24, insert:

4 “**SECTION 2.** Section 3, chapter 823, Oregon Laws 2009, as amended by section 7, chapter 30,
5 Oregon Laws 2010, is amended to read:

6 “**Sec. 3.** (1) After deduction of the cost of administration of the Pacific Wonderland registration
7 plate program, the Department of Transportation shall transfer 50 percent of the moneys from the
8 surcharge imposed by section 2, chapter 823, Oregon Laws 2009, to the Oregon State Capitol Foun-
9 dation for the [*purpose of establishing and maintaining an Oregon History Center at the State Capitol*
10 *or on the grounds of the State Capitol State Park*] **general purposes of the foundation under ORS**
11 **173.500** and 50 percent to the Oregon Historical Society.

12 “(2) As used in this section, the cost of administration of the Pacific Wonderland registration
13 plate program is the sum of all department expenses for the issuance or transfer of Pacific
14 Wonderland registration plates under section 2, chapter 823, Oregon Laws 2009, that are above the
15 normal costs of issuing, renewing and transferring registration plates in the normal course of the
16 business of the department. These expenses include, but are not limited to, the costs of collecting
17 the Pacific Wonderland registration plate surcharge and transferring Pacific Wonderland registra-
18 tion plates.

19 “**SECTION 3.** Section 4, chapter 823, Oregon Laws 2009, as amended by section 8, chapter 30,
20 Oregon Laws 2010, is amended to read:

21 “**Sec. 4.** (1) Notwithstanding ORS 184.642, the Department of Transportation may pay an amount
22 up to \$150,000 from the Department of Transportation Operating Fund for expenses incurred in ini-
23 tiating the Pacific Wonderland registration plate program established in section 2, chapter 823,
24 Oregon Laws 2009, including but not limited to registration plate design, computer programming and
25 production setup. Any portion of the amount paid that is not used for initiating the Pacific
26 Wonderland registration plate program shall be transferred to the account established under sub-
27 section (2) of this section.

28 “(2) Notwithstanding section 3, chapter 823, Oregon Laws 2009, after deduction of the cost of
29 administration of the Pacific Wonderland registration plate program, the department shall transfer
30 the moneys from the surcharge imposed by section 2, chapter 823, Oregon Laws 2009, to an account
31 in the Department of Transportation Operating Fund until sufficient funds have accumulated for the
32 purpose described in subsection (3) of this section.

33 “(3) When the department determines that moneys in sufficient amount are available in the ac-
34 count established under subsection (2) of this section, the department shall reimburse the Depart-
35 ment of Transportation Operating Fund, without interest, in an amount equal to the amount paid

1 from the Department of Transportation Operating Fund for the costs of initiating the Pacific
2 Wonderland registration plate program.

3 “(4) Any moneys remaining in the account established under subsection (2) of this section after
4 deduction of the reimbursement required under subsection (3) of this section shall be transferred to
5 the Oregon State Capitol Foundation for the [*purpose of establishing and maintaining an Oregon*
6 *History Center at the State Capitol or on the grounds of the State Capitol State Park*] **general pur-**
7 **poses of the foundation under ORS 173.500** and to the Oregon Historical Society. Of the moneys
8 transferred under this subsection, 50 percent shall be transferred to the Oregon State Capitol
9 Foundation and 50 percent shall be transferred to the Oregon Historical Society.

10 “**SECTION 4. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
12 **on its passage.”**
