

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 460**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after the semicolon delete the rest of the line  
2 and insert “amending section 116, chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled  
3 House Bill 3400).”.

4 Delete lines 4 through 19 and insert:

5 **“SECTION 1.** If House Bill 3400 becomes law, section 116, chapter \_\_\_,  
6 Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 3400), is amended to read:

7 **“Sec. 116.** (1) A person responsible for a marijuana grow site under ORS  
8 475.304 may apply for a license under section 19, chapter 1, Oregon Laws  
9 2015, to produce marijuana at the address of the marijuana grow site, pro-  
10 vided that all individuals registered with the Oregon Health Authority to  
11 produce marijuana at the address are listed on the application submitted to  
12 the Oregon Liquor Control Commission under section 28, chapter 1, Oregon  
13 Laws 2015.

14 **“(2)** Notwithstanding any other provision of sections 3 to 70, chapter 1,  
15 Oregon Laws 2015, the commission may issue a license under section 19,  
16 chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015, to a person responsible for a marijuana grow  
17 site under ORS 475.304 if the person responsible for the marijuana grow site:

18 **“(a)** Meets any criminal background check requirements established by  
19 the commission by rule;

20 **“(b)** Agrees to be subject to the provisions of sections 3 to 70, chapter 1,  
21 Oregon Laws 2015, including section 59, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015, and  
22 section 34, **chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 3400)**

1 [of this 2015 Act], and rules adopted under sections 3 to 70, chapter 1, Oregon  
2 Laws 2015, that apply to marijuana producers; and

3 “(c) Submits proof, in a form and manner prescribed by the commission,  
4 of having obtained the permission to apply for licensure under section 19,  
5 chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015, of each individual who holds a registry iden-  
6 tification card issued under ORS 475.309 for whom the person produces  
7 marijuana at the address of the marijuana grow site.

8 “(3) The commission by rule or order may waive the application of any  
9 rule adopted under sections 3 to 70, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015, to a person  
10 responsible for a marijuana grow site that holds a license under section 19,  
11 chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015.

12 “(4) A person responsible for a marijuana grow site that holds a license  
13 under section 19, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015:

14 “(a) May not possess more than the amount or number of marijuana  
15 plants permitted pursuant to ORS 475.300 to 475.346 **on the day that the**  
16 **person responsible for the marijuana grow site submitted the applica-**  
17 **tion for licensure to the commission;**

18 “(b) Must allow each marijuana plant to be tracked using the system de-  
19 veloped and maintained under section 23, **chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws**  
20 **2015 (Enrolled House Bill 3400)** [of this 2015 Act];

21 “(c) May sell immature marijuana plants and usable marijuana in excess  
22 of amounts produced for individuals who hold a registry identification card  
23 issued under ORS 475.309 to a person who holds a license under section 20,  
24 21 or 22, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015, in accordance with rules adopted by  
25 the commission; and

26 “(d) May transfer marijuana and usable marijuana to other registrants  
27 under ORS 475.300 to 475.346 in accordance with rules adopted by the au-  
28 thority.

29 “(5) In a form and manner prescribed by the commission, a person re-  
30 sponsible for a marijuana grow site that holds a license under section 19,

1 chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015, may surrender the person's license. If the per-  
2 son surrenders the person's license, the person is no longer subject to the  
3 provisions of this section.

4 “(6) Notwithstanding ORS 475.331, the authority may provide information  
5 to the commission as is necessary for the commission to determine whether  
6 a person responsible for a marijuana grow site that holds a license under  
7 section 19, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015, is in compliance with this section.

8 “(7) This section does not prohibit or otherwise restrict the duties, func-  
9 tions and powers of a person responsible for a marijuana grow site as set  
10 forth in ORS 475.300 to 475.346, except that the person is not subject to any  
11 requirement related to the reporting or tracking of mature marijuana plants  
12 and usable marijuana.”
