Public Hearing

HB 2857

Prohibits certain activities by, and specifies additional duties for, performing rights society in notifying business proprietors concerning proprietors' duties with respect to performing copyrighted musical works and in negotiating contracts for paying royalties for performing copyrighted musical works.

HB 3146

Specifies that wage requirements for certain economic development programs must be determined with respect to permanent positions.

HB 3170

Extends collective bargaining rights to certain faculty members of public university with academic rather than administrative focus.

HB 2907

Provides that specialized building inspector authorized by, but not employed by, municipality to administer and enforce parts of state building code specialty code is appointee of municipality for purpose of inspector certification statutes.

HB 2265

Allows parties to agree in writing to starting date for 150-day period after which parties involved in negotiations over terms of collective bargaining agreement may notify Employment Relations Board of need for mediator.
