Public Hearing

- HB 2661
Requires long term care referral provider to be certified by Health Licensing Office.
- HB 2070 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits
Extends sunset for tax credit for affordable housing lenders.
- HB 2852 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits
Extends sunset for tax credit for affordable housing lenders.
- HB 2315 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Provides that corporate excise tax credit allowed to lenders that finance affordable housing is not barred by receipt of housing vouchers by tenants.

Work Session

- HB 2216
Requires Department of Human Services to adopt rules to establish Oregon Foster Children's Sibling Bill of Rights.
- HB 2401
Requires Department of Human Services and Department of Justice to provide trauma-informed training and curriculum to child welfare personnel.

- HB 2500 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Department of Human Services to develop and implement training and continuing education curriculum for department caseworkers that informs and instructs caseworkers on their roles in juvenile dependency proceedings.
- HB 2221
Requires Oregon Health Authority and Department of Consumer and Business Services to report to Legislative Assembly each calendar quarter on implementation of requirements to reimburse cost of child abuse medical assessments conducted by community assessment centers.
