Work Session

- SB 95 B
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/30/2017 AGENDA: Requires certain securities professionals to report suspected financial exploitation of vulnerable persons to Department of Consumer and Business Services.
- SB 257 A
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/30/2017 AGENDA: Modifies crime of official misconduct in the first degree to include commission of official misconduct in the second degree when public servant is aware of and consciously disregards risk that violation places vulnerable person in danger of physical injury or of being victim of sex crime or causes withholding of necessities from vulnerable person.
- SB 690 A
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/30/2017 AGENDA: Establishes procedures for petitioning for and issuing Certificate of Good Standing.
- SB 714 A
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/30/2017 AGENDA: Allows court to include reasonable residency restrictions as special condition of probation for person convicted of stalking or violating court's stalking protective order.
- SB 1055
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/30/2017 AGENDA: Expands definition of "deployment" or "deployed" to include "mobilization" of member of Armed Forces, National Guard or reserve component in specific laws affecting certain family law judgments.

Note change: SB 95 B, SB 257 A, SB 690 A, SB 714 A, and SB 1055 have been carried over from the 5/30/2017 agenda.
