SB 299 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Bureau of Labor and Industries to study issue of sick leave in Oregon.

The work session on SB 329 is scheduled solely for the purpose of passing it to another committee.

SB 329

Extends state preemption of local governmental authority to regulate work schedule requirements.

The work sessions for SB 559 and SB 560 are scheduled solely for the purpose of sending them back to the Senate President's Office for referral to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

SB 559

Changes calculation of final average salary for purposes of Public Employees Retirement System to use five years of salary instead of three years, for salary paid on and after January 1, 2018.

SB 560

Redirects employee contributions made by member of system from individual account program to account to be used to pay for member's pension or other retirement benefits accrued on or after January 1, 2018.
