

**SB 5529**

**Lottery and CFA Allocation**

SB 5529 allocates and transfers Lottery Funds, and funds from the Criminal Fine Account and Oregon Marijuana Account, to finance expenditures approved in the budget. Lottery Funds are allocated to support the State School Fund and pay debt service on lottery revenue bonds.

Other lottery allocations provide support to the Oregon Business Development Department, to counties for economic development programs and county fairs, to public universities for intercollegiate athletics, academic scholarships and the Outdoor School program, to the Oregon Health Authority for gambling addiction prevention and treatment programs, and to the Governor's Office for Regional Solutions program staff.

Allocations of Ballot Measure 96 Lottery Funds, dedicated to veterans' services, are allocated from the Veterans' Services Fund for the first time. Measure 96 funds are allocated to the Department of Veterans' Affairs and the Department of Housing and Community Services for veterans' programs.

The bill also allocates \$77 million from the Criminal Fine Account for agency and county programs; and \$162 million of Marijuana Tax revenue to the State School Fund, mental health, alcoholism and drug abuse prevention and treatment programs, and the State Police.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends SB 5529 be amended by the –3 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
