Measure Description:

Establishes grant program under which Department of Education awards grants to school districts for percentage of certain student transportation costs for which school district does not receive any amount in distributions from State School Fund.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Education, School Districts

Analysis:

The bill establishes a grant program within the Department of Education (ODE) to awards grants to school districts for a percentage of certain student transportation costs for which school districts do not receive any amount in distributions from the State School Fund. The bill appropriates \$5 million General Fund in the 2017-19 biennium to ODE for grants to school districts.

The fiscal impact to ODE associated with rule making and the administration of the grants is anticipated to be minimal and absorbable within existing budgetary parameters. Funding for future biennia is undetermined and will be subject to the amount appropriated by the Legislative Assembly.
