Summary of Revenue Changes

House Bill 2720 appropriates \$80,000 General Fund to the Oregon Department of Education for a study of virtual public charter schools.

Summary of Education Subcommittee Action

House Bill 2720 requires the Oregon Department of Education to conduct a study of virtual public charter schools and deliver the report results to the Legislature by September 15, 2018. The bill makes a one-time appropriation of \$80,000 for the study. A progress report is due by December 15, 2017. The study results will help guide the regular collection of data from virtual public charter schools.

The report is required to include the following elements:

- Resource availability for virtual public charter schools and non-virtual public charter schools
- Financial and working relationships between school sponsors and the schools
- School populations, including demographics, prior educational experience, and number of credit deficiencies.
- Comparisons of virtual public charter school populations with non-virtual public charter schools.
- Growth of students as well as graduation, test scores or ranking systems.
- Information on national trends and best practices for online learning.

The appropriation will provide funding for temporary personal services and for Services and Supplies.
