

# House Bill 2236

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Governor Kate Brown)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Environmental Quality to conduct study and develop recommendations related to emissions of air contaminants from industrial sources. Requires department to present results of study to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to environment and natural resources no later than September 15, 2018.

Sunset December 31, 2018.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to industrial sources of air pollution; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Environmental Quality shall study alternatives for**  
5 **regulating emissions of air contaminants from industrial sources, and shall identify and de-**  
6 **velop recommendations, which may include recommendations for legislation, for updating the**  
7 **regulation of air pollution or air contamination in this state as necessary to protect public**  
8 **health.**

9 (2) The department shall present the results of the study to the interim committees of  
10 the Legislative Assembly related to the environment and natural resources no later than  
11 September 15, 2018.

12 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on December 31, 2018.**

13 **SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
14 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**  
15 **on its passage.**
