SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Adjusts certain fees imposed by Department of Transportation.

Reorganizes laws related to motor vehicle registration, titling, driving privileges and vehicle business certificates.

Directs Department of Transportation, once every two years, to conduct study on driver and motor vehicle services costs or examination of data collected since previous study. Requires department to report on study or examination each odd-numbered year to legislative committees with primary responsibility for transportation.

Becomes operative July 1, 2018.

11 **SECTION 1.** ORS 803.134 is amended to read:

12 803.134. A person submitting a transitional ownership record to the Department of Transporta-
13 tion shall pay a fee of [*\$13*] **\$20** to the department. The fee shall be paid at the time of submission
14 of the record unless the department by rule establishes alternative payment methods.

15 **SECTION 2.** ORS 803.575 is amended to read:

19 is in addition to the fee established under ORS 803.570 unless otherwise provided in the following:

21 (2) Customized registration plates issued under ORS 805.240:

22 (a) For original issuance or renewal, \$50 annual fee.

6 **MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION FEES**

8 **SECTION 6.** ORS 803.420 is amended to read:

9 803.420. *[This section establishes registration fees for vehicles. If there is uncertainty as to the*
10 *classification of a vehicle for purposes of the payment of registration fees under the vehicle code, the*
11 *Department of Transportation may classify the vehicle to assure that registration fees for the vehicle*
12 *are the same as for vehicles the department determines to be comparable. The registration fees for the*
13 *vehicle shall be those based on the classification determined by the department. Except as otherwise*
14 *provided in this section, or unless the vehicle is registered quarterly, the fees described in this section*
15 *are for an entire registration period for the vehicle as described under ORS 803.415. The department*
16 *shall apportion any fee under this section to reflect the number of quarters registered for a vehicle*
17 *registered for a quarterly registration period under ORS 803.415. The fees are payable when a vehicle*
18 *is registered and upon renewal of registration. Except as provided in ORS 801.041 (3) and 801.042 (7),*
19 *the fee shall be increased by any amount established by the governing body of a county or by the*
20 *governing body of a district, as defined in ORS 801.237, under ORS 801.041 or 801.042 as an addi-*
21 *tional registration fee for the vehicle. The fees for registration of vehicles are as follows:]*

22 (1) **The vehicle registration fees imposed under this section shall be based on the classi-**
23 **fications determined by the Department of Transportation by rule. The department may**
24 **classify a vehicle to ensure that registration fees for the vehicle are the same as for other**
25 **vehicles the department determines to be comparable.**

26 (2) **Except as otherwise provided in this section, or unless the vehicle is registered**
27 **quarterly, the fees described in this section are for an entire registration period for the ve-**
28 **hicle as described under ORS 803.415. For a vehicle registered for a quarterly registration**
29 **period under ORS 803.415, the department shall apportion any fee under this section to re-**
30 **fect the number of quarters registered.**

31 (3) **Vehicle registration fees are due when a vehicle is registered and when the registered**
32 **owner renews the registration.**

33 (4) **In addition to the registration fees listed in this section, a county or a district may**
34 **impose an additional registration fee as provided under ORS 801.041 and 801.042.**

35 (5) **A rental or leasing company, as defined in ORS 221.275, that elects to initially register**
36 **a vehicle for an annual or biennial registration period shall pay a fee of \$1 in addition to the**
37 **vehicle registration fee provided under this section.**

38 (6) **The registration fees for each year of the registration period for vehicles subject to**
39 **biennial registration are as follows:**

4 **(d) Low-speed vehicles, \$43.**

5 **(e) Medium-speed electric vehicles, \$43.**

6 **(7) The registration fees for vehicles that are subject to biennial registration and that**
7 **are listed in this subsection are as follows:**

8 **(a) State-owned vehicles registered under ORS 805.045 and undercover vehicles registered**
9 **under ORS 805.060, \$3.50 upon registration or renewal.**

10 **(b) Fixed load vehicles:**

11 **(A) If a declaration of weight described under ORS 803.435 is submitted establishing the**
12 **weight of the vehicle at 3,000 pounds or less, \$54.**

13 **(B) If no declaration of weight is submitted or if the weight of the vehicles is in excess**
14 **of 3,000 pounds, \$75.**

15 **(c) Travel trailers, special use trailers, campers and motor homes, based on length as**
16 **determined under ORS 803.425:**

17 **(A) Trailers or campers that are 6 to 10 feet in length, \$81.**

18 **(B) Trailers or campers over 10 feet in length, \$81 plus \$6.75 a foot for each foot of length**
19 **over the first 10 feet.**

20 **(C) Motor homes that are 6 to 14 feet in length, \$86.**

21 **(D) Motor homes over 14 feet in length, \$126 plus \$7.50 a foot for each foot of length over**
22 **the first 10 feet.**

23 **(8) The registration fee for trailers for hire that are equipped with pneumatic tires made**
24 **of an elastic material and that are not travel trailers or trailers registered under permanent**
25 **registration is \$27.**

26 **(9) The registration fee for vehicles subject to ownership registration is as follows:**

27 **(a) Government-owned vehicles registered under ORS 805.040, \$3.50.**

28 **(b) Vehicles registered with special registration for disabled veterans under ORS 805.100,**
29 **\$15.**

30 **(c) School vehicles registered under ORS 805.050, \$7.50.**

31 **(10) The registration fee for vehicles subject to permanent registration is as follows:**

32 [(7)] **(a) Antique vehicles registered under ORS 805.010, [~~\$54~~] \$81.**

33 [(8)] **(b) Vehicles of special interest registered under ORS 805.020, \$81.**

34 **(c) Racing activity vehicles registered under ORS 805.035, \$81.**

35 **(d) Trailers, \$10.**

36 **(11) The registration fee for trailers registered as part of a fleet under an agreement**
37 **reached pursuant to ORS 802.500 is the same fee as the fee for vehicles of the same type**
38 **registered under other provisions of the Oregon Vehicle Code.**

39 **(12) The registration fee for vehicles with proportional registration under ORS 826.009,**
40 **or proportioned fleet registration under ORS 826.011, is the same fee as the fee for vehicles**
41 **of the same type under this section except that the fees shall be fixed on an apportioned**
42 **basis as provided under the agreement established under ORS 826.007.**

43 **(13) In addition to any other registration fees charged for registration of vehicles in fleets**
44 **under ORS 805.120, the department may charge the following fees:**

45 **(a) \$2 service charge for each vehicle entered into a fleet.**

(b) \$1 service charge for each vehicle in the fleet at the time of renewal.

[(9) Electric vehicles and hybrid vehicles that use electricity and another source of motive power, as follows:]

[(a) The registration fee for an electric or hybrid vehicle not otherwise described in this subsection is \$43 for each year of the registration period.]

[(b) The registration fee for electric or hybrid vehicles that have two or three wheels is \$43. This paragraph does not apply to electric or hybrid mopeds. Electric or hybrid mopeds are subject to the same registration fee as otherwise provided for mopeds under this section.]

[(c) The registration fees for the following electric or hybrid vehicles are the same as for comparable nonelectric vehicles described in this section plus 50 percent of such fee:]

[(A) Motor homes.]

[(B) Commercial buses.]

[(C) Vehicles registered as farm vehicles under ORS 805.300.]

[(D) Vehicles required to establish registration weight under ORS 803.430 or 826.013.]

[(10)] (14)(a) The registration fee for motor vehicles required to establish a registration weight under ORS 803.430 or 826.013, tow vehicles used to transport property for hire other than as described in ORS 822.210[,] and commercial buses[,] is as provided in the following chart, based upon the weight submitted in the declaration of weight prepared under ORS 803.435 or 826.015:

1 (j) Vehicles with a registration weight of 26,001 pounds or more described in ORS 803.420 [(10)
2 or (11)] **(14)(a) or (b)**.

3 (k) Vehicles registered as farm vehicles under the provisions of ORS 805.300.

4 (L) Travel trailers, campers and motor homes.

5 (m) Vehicles registered to an employment address as provided in ORS 802.250 when the eligible
6 public employee or household member's residence address is not within the county of the employ-
7 ment address. The department may adopt rules it considers necessary for the administration of this
8 paragraph.

9 (8) Any registration fee imposed by the governing body of a district must be a fixed amount not
10 to exceed, with respect to any vehicle class, the registration fee established under ORS 803.420
11 [(1)] **(6)(a)**. For vehicles on which a flat fee is imposed under ORS 803.420, the fee must be a whole
12 dollar amount.
