

House Bill 2391

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Health Care)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to submit blueprint for basic health plan to Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services by December 31, 2017.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to access to health care; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall, no later than December 31, 2017,**
5 **submit for certification by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services a blueprint for a**
6 **basic health plan in accordance with 42 U.S.C. 18051 and 42 C.F.R. part 600.**

7 **(2) Immediately after receiving certification of the blueprint by the Centers for Medicare**
8 **and Medicaid Services, the authority shall notify the committees or interim committees re-**
9 **lated to health in the House of Representatives and the Senate.**

10 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed December 31, 2019.**

11 **SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
12 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**
13 **on its passage.**
