

House Bill 2987

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Renames crime of giving false information to a peace officer for issuance or service of a citation or for an arrest on a warrant to giving false information to a peace officer in connection with a citation or warrant. Expands crime to include person providing false information to peace officer when there is outstanding warrant for person's arrest. Punishes by maximum of one year's imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both.

2 Relating to giving false information to a peace officer; amending ORS 162.385.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 162.385 is amended to read:

5 162.385. (1) A person commits the crime of giving false information to a peace officer [*for issu-*
6 *ance or service of a citation or for an arrest on a warrant*] **in connection with a citation or warrant**
7 if the person knowingly uses or gives a false or fictitious name, address or date of birth to any peace
8 officer [*for the purpose of*] **when:**

9 (a) The [*officer's*] **peace officer is** issuing or serving the person a citation under authority of
10 ORS 133.055 to 133.076 or ORS chapter 153; or

11 [*(b) The officer's arresting the person on a warrant.*]

12 **(b) There is an outstanding warrant for the person's arrest.**

13 (2) [*A person who violates this section commits*] **Giving false information to a peace officer in**
14 **connection with a citation or warrant is** a Class A misdemeanor.
