

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3355

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 25, delete “seven” and insert “nine”.
2 Delete lines 27 through 29.
- 3 On page 2, delete lines 1 and 2 and insert:
4 “(a) The State Board of Psychologist Examiners shall appoint:
5 “(A) Three licensed psychologists, one of whom is a member of the State Board of Psychologist
6 Examiners and one of whom has completed a clinical residency program; and
7 “(B) One member of the public who is a consumer of the services provided by a licensed psy-
8 chologist.
- 9 “(b) The Oregon Medical Board shall appoint four prescribing physicians, at least one of whom
10 is a psychiatrist, one of whom practices as a primary care physician and one of whom has expertise
11 in the treatment of children.
- 12 “(c) The State Board of Pharmacy shall appoint one pharmacist licensed under ORS chapter 689
13 who has expertise in psychotropic medications.”.
- 14 Delete lines 9 through 40 and insert:
15 “(3) The members of the committee shall elect one of the licensed psychologists appointed under
16 subsection (1)(a) of this section as the chairperson of the committee.
- 17 “(4) The committee shall:
18 “(a) Review and make recommendations to the State Board of Psychologist Examiners on clin-
19 ical residency programs proposed by applicants seeking a conditional certificate of prescriptive au-
20 thority;
21 “(b) Review and make recommendations to the State Board of Psychologist Examiners on appli-
22 cations submitted for certificates of prescriptive authority;
23 “(c) Develop and make recommendations to the State Board of Psychologist Examiners regarding
24 the formulary and make recommendations for annual revisions of the formulary;
25 “(d) Develop and make recommendations to the State Board of Psychologist Examiners regard-
26 ing standards, examinations and continuing education for prescribing psychologists; and
27 “(e) Report to the State Board of Psychologist Examiners regarding the use of prescriptive au-
28 thority by prescribing psychologists.
- 29 “(5) A majority of the members of the committee constitutes a quorum for the transaction of
30 business.
- 31 “(6) Official action by the committee requires the approval of a majority of the members of the
32 committee.
- 33 “(7) The committee may seek the assistance of a neutral third party in resolving disagreements
34 among the committee members and facilitating the collaborative process.
- 35 “(8) The committee shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson or a

1 majority of the members of the committee.

2 “(9) The committee may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the committee.

3 “(10) The State Board of Psychologist Examiners shall provide staff support to the committee.

4 “(11) Members of the committee are not entitled to compensation, but may be reimbursed from
5 funds available to the State Board of Psychologist Examiners for actual and necessary travel and
6 other expenses incurred by committee members in the performance of their official duties in the
7 manner and amount provided in ORS 292.495.”.

8 On page 3, line 4, delete “accredited” and insert “designated”.

9 On page 4, line 7, delete “two” and insert “12”.

10 On page 6, line 38, delete “Two” and insert “Three”.

11 In line 39, delete “Two” and insert “Three”.
