

# House Bill 5006

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Emergency Board for allocations during biennium.  
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
5 **ated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General**  
6 **Fund, the amount of \$30,000,000 for the purposes for which the Emergency Board lawfully**  
7 **may allocate funds.**

8 **SECTION 2. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
9 **ated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General**  
10 **Fund, the amount of \$100,000,000, to be allocated to state agencies for state employee com-**  
11 **ensation changes for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017.**

12 **(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated**  
13 **by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2018, the moneys remaining on that date be-**  
14 **come available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.**

15 **SECTION 3. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
16 **ated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General**  
17 **Fund, the amount of \$10,000,000, to be allocated to state agencies for compensation changes**  
18 **for home health care and child care workers who are not state employees, for the biennium**  
19 **beginning July 1, 2017.**

20 **(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated**  
21 **by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2018, the moneys remaining on that date be-**  
22 **come available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.**

23 **SECTION 4. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
24 **ated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General**  
25 **Fund, the amount of \$2,500,000, to be allocated to the Housing and Community Services De-**  
26 **partment for the purpose of providing emergency housing and shelter to victims of domestic**  
27 **violence.**

28 **(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated**  
29 **by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2018, the moneys remaining on that date be-**  
30 **come available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.**

31 **SECTION 5. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**

1 **priated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General**  
2 **Fund, the amount of \$3,000,000, to be allocated to the Department of Environmental Quality**  
3 **and the Oregon Military Department for the purpose of enhancing the state's capacity to**  
4 **respond to and prevent severe incidents.**

5 **(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated**  
6 **by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2018, the moneys remaining on that date be-**  
7 **come available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.**

8 **SECTION 6. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
9 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**  
10 **July 1, 2017.**
