CHAPTER .....

AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Public Defense Services Commission; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Public Defense Services Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following purposes:**

- (1) Appellate Division ..... \$ 18,194,890
- (2) Professional services..... \$276,304,521
- (3) Contract and Business Services Division..... \$ 4,423,808

**SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Public Defense Services Commission, for the following purposes:**

- (1) Professional services..... \$ 4,244,845
- (2) Contract and Business Services Division..... \$ 709,468

**SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect July 1, 2017.**
