

Senate Bill 189

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Establishes Task Force on Airport Subsidies. Sunsets task force on December 31, 2019.
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to the Task Force on Airport Subsidies; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Task Force on Airport Subsidies is established.**

5 **(2) The task force consists of seven members as follows:**

6 **(a) The President of the Senate shall appoint one member from among members of the**
7 **Senate.**

8 **(b) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint one member from among**
9 **members of the House of Representatives.**

10 **(c) The Governor shall appoint four members as follows:**

11 **(A) Two members of the public.**

12 **(B) One representative of a public airport.**

13 **(C) One representative of a private airport.**

14 **(d) The Director of the Oregon Department of Aviation or the director's designee.**

15 **(3) The task force shall conduct a study on the benefits, if any, the State of Oregon re-**
16 **ceives for subsidizing public and private airports.**

17 **(4) A majority of the voting members of the task force constitutes a quorum for the**
18 **transaction of business.**

19 **(5) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a majority of the voting**
20 **members of the task force.**

21 **(6) Members of the Legislative Assembly appointed to the task force are nonvoting**
22 **members of the task force and may act in an advisory capacity only.**

23 **(7) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as chairperson.**

24 **(8) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority shall make an appoint-**
25 **ment to become immediately effective.**

26 **(9) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson**
27 **or of a majority of the voting members of the task force.**

28 **(10) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the task force.**

29 **(11) The task force shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and**
30 **may include recommendations for legislation, to an interim committee of the Legislative**

1 **Assembly related to general government and accountability no later than September 15, 2018.**

2 **(12) The Legislative Fiscal Officer shall provide staff support to the task force.**

3 **(13) Members of the task force who are not members of the Legislative Assembly are not**
4 **entitled to compensation or reimbursement for expenses and serve as volunteers on the task**
5 **force.**

6 **(14) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist**
7 **the task force in the performance of the task force's duties and, to the extent permitted by**
8 **laws relating to confidentiality, to furnish information and advice the members of the task**
9 **force consider necessary to perform their duties.**

10 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on December 31, 2019.**

11 **SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
12 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**
13 **on its passage.**

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
