

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 274

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 6 through 30.
- 2 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 8 and insert:
- 3 **“SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, ‘post-secondary institution of education’ means:**
- 4 **“(a) A public university listed in ORS 352.002;**
- 5 **“(b) A community college operated under ORS chapter 341; or**
- 6 **“(c) An Oregon-based, generally accredited, private institution of higher education.**
- 7 **“(2) Each post-secondary institution of education that provides housing for students shall**
- 8 **provide to each student enrolling or registering at the institution for the first time infor-**
- 9 **mation on vaccine-preventable diseases known to occur in individuals between 16 and 21**
- 10 **years of age, including:**
- 11 **“(a) The signs and symptoms associated with, and options for treating, vaccine-**
- 12 **preventable diseases known to occur in individuals between 16 and 21 years of age;**
- 13 **“(b) The circumstances that create a risk of acquiring a vaccine-preventable disease**
- 14 **known to occur in individuals between 16 and 21 years of age, including the circumstance of**
- 15 **living in group quarters;**
- 16 **“(c) Recommendations by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention with respect**
- 17 **to vaccines recommended to be categorized as category A or category B by the federal Ad-**
- 18 **visory Committee on Immunization Practices, and vaccines recognized as category A or**
- 19 **category B by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention;**
- 20 **“(d) Any additional information on the availability, benefits and risks and limitations of**
- 21 **vaccines for vaccine-preventable diseases known to occur in individuals between 16 and 21**
- 22 **years of age, as determined by the institution; and**
- 23 **“(e) Information on where to receive a vaccination.**
- 24 **“(3) At a minimum, information provided under subsection (2) of this section must cover**
- 25 **vaccine-preventable diseases for which the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention re-**
- 26 **commend vaccination for individuals between 16 and 21 years of age.**
- 27 **“(4) In developing information on vaccine-preventable diseases under this section, a**
- 28 **post-secondary institution of education shall consult the Oregon Health Authority or the**
- 29 **Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.**
- 30 **“(5) If a post-secondary institution of education provides electronic enrollment or regis-**
- 31 **tration for students enrolling or registering at the institution for the first time, the institu-**
- 32 **tion shall provide the information required by this section electronically at the time of**
- 33 **enrollment or registration.**
- 34 **“(6) This section does not create a private right of action against a post-secondary in-**
- 35 **stitution of education.”.**
