

**HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 36  
(INCLUDING AMENDMENTS TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS)**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “and amending ORS 807.050 and 807.072” and insert  
2 “amending ORS 807.040, 807.050, 807.072, 807.110, 807.140, 807.285, 807.370 and 807.730 and section  
3 15, chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 37); repealing section 8, chapter \_\_\_,  
4 Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 37); and declaring an emergency”.

5 On page 3, line 21, delete “effective date” and insert “operative date specified in section 10”.

6 In line 23, delete “effective date” and insert “operative date specified in section 10”.

7 After line 23, insert:

8 “**SECTION 4.** ORS 807.040 is amended to read:

9 “807.040. (1) The Department of Transportation shall issue a driver license to any person who  
10 complies with all of the following requirements:

11 “(a) The person must complete an application for a license under ORS 807.050.

12 “(b) As required by ORS 807.021 and 807.730, the person must provide the Social Security num-  
13 ber assigned to the person by the United States Social Security Administration and proof of legal  
14 presence in the United States or, if the person is not eligible for a Social Security number, proof  
15 of legal presence in the United States and proof that the person is not eligible for a Social Security  
16 number.

17 “(c) The person must submit to collection of biometric data by the department that establish the  
18 identity of the person as described in ORS 807.024.

19 “(d) The person must not be ineligible for the license under ORS 807.060 and must be eligible  
20 for the license under ORS 807.062.

21 “(e) The person must successfully pass all examination requirements under ORS 807.070 for the  
22 class of license sought.

23 “(f) The person must pay the appropriate license fee under ORS 807.370 for the class of license  
24 sought.

25 “(g) The person must pay the Student Driver Training Fund eligibility fee.

26 “(h) If the application is for a commercial driver license, the person must be the holder of a  
27 Class C license or any higher class of license.

28 “(i) If the application is for a commercial driver license, the person must submit to the depart-  
29 ment, in a form approved by the department, the report of a medical examination that establishes  
30 that the person meets the medical requirements for the particular class of license. The department,  
31 by rule, shall establish medical requirements for purposes of this paragraph. The medical require-  
32 ments established under this paragraph may include any requirements the department determines  
33 are necessary for the safe operation of vehicles permitted to be operated under the class of license  
34 for which the requirements are established.

1 “(j) If the application is for a commercial driver license, the person must:  
2 “(A) Have at least one year’s driving experience, including relevant experience obtained in the  
3 military;  
4 “(B) Not be subject to a lifetime suspension of commercial driving privileges under ORS 809.520;  
5 “(C) Not be otherwise ineligible to hold a commercial driver license;  
6 “(D) Hold a commercial learner driver permit if the person must complete a skills demonstration  
7 under ORS 807.070 (3); and  
8 “(E) In addition to meeting the requirement of providing proof of legal presence under ORS  
9 807.021 and this section, the person must submit valid documentation, as defined by the department  
10 by rule, that the person is a citizen or permanent legal resident of the United States.  
11 “(2) **Subsection (1)(j)(E) of this section does not apply to a limited term commercial  
12 driver license or a limited term commercial learner driver permit issued under ORS 807.730.**  
13 “[2] (3) The department shall work with other agencies and organizations to attempt to im-  
14 prove the issuance system for driver licenses.  
15 “**SECTION 5.** ORS 807.285 is amended to read:  
16 “807.285. (1) The Department of Transportation shall issue commercial learner driver permits in  
17 the manner provided by this section. Except as provided in this section, a person who is issued a  
18 commercial learner driver permit may exercise the same driving privileges as those under the class  
19 of commercial driver license or endorsement for which the permit is issued. Except as provided in  
20 this section, a commercial learner driver permit is subject to the provisions, conditions, prohibitions  
21 and penalties applicable to a license or endorsement granting the same driving privileges.  
22 “(2) The department may issue commercial learner driver permits under this section that grant  
23 the driving privileges of a Class A commercial, Class B commercial, or Class C commercial driver  
24 license, subject to the requirements and restrictions of subsections (6) and (7) of this section.  
25 “(3) An applicant for a commercial learner driver permit must be 18 years of age or older.  
26 “(4) In addition to meeting the requirement of providing proof of legal presence under ORS  
27 807.021 and 807.040, an applicant for a commercial learner driver permit must submit valid doc-  
28 umentation, as defined by the department by rule, that the person is a citizen or permanent legal  
29 resident of the United States. **The requirements of this subsection do not apply to an applicant  
30 for a limited term commercial learner driver permit issued under ORS 807.730.**  
31 “(5) A commercial learner driver permit is valid for a period of one year from the date of issu-  
32 ance and is not renewable.  
33 “(6) The holder of the commercial learner driver permit may not operate a commercial motor  
34 vehicle unless the holder has the permit in the holder’s immediate possession and is accompanied  
35 by a person who is at least 21 years of age and who holds a class of commercial driver license and  
36 endorsements that grant the driving privileges required to operate the vehicle. The accompanying  
37 person must have the permit holder under observation and direct supervision and must be occupying  
38 a seat beside the holder of the permit or, in the case of a commercial passenger vehicle, directly  
39 behind or in the first row behind the driver.  
40 “(7) The holder of a commercial learner permit may not operate:  
41 “(a) Any vehicle transporting hazardous materials.  
42 “(b) A tank vehicle, unless the tank is empty.  
43 “(c) A commercial passenger vehicle while transporting passengers, unless the passengers are  
44 federal or state auditors or inspectors, test examiners or other trainees and there is a commercial  
45 driver license holder accompanying the permit holder as required by subsection (6) of this section.

1 “(d) A school bus while transporting passengers, unless the other passengers are federal or state  
2 auditors or inspectors, test examiners or other trainees and there is a commercial driver license  
3 holder accompanying the permit holder as required by subsection (6) of this section.

4 “(e) A commercial motor vehicle combination consisting of more than one towed vehicle.

5 “(8) A commercial learner driver permit must contain all of the applicable information described  
6 in ORS 807.110 (1) and a prominent statement that the permit is a commercial learner permit or  
7 CLP.

8 “(9) An applicant for a commercial learner driver permit must pay the commercial learner driver  
9 permit fee established under ORS 807.370.

10 **“SECTION 5a. If Senate Bill 37 becomes law, section 8, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2017**  
11 **(Enrolled Senate Bill 37) (amending ORS 807.285), is repealed and ORS 807.285, as amended**  
12 **by section 5 of this 2017 Act, is amended to read:**

13 “807.285. (1) The Department of Transportation shall issue commercial learner driver permits in  
14 the manner provided by this section. Except as provided in this section, a person who is issued a  
15 commercial learner driver permit may exercise the same driving privileges as those under the class  
16 of commercial driver license or endorsement for which the permit is issued. Except as provided in  
17 this section, a commercial learner driver permit is subject to the provisions, conditions, prohibitions  
18 and penalties applicable to a license or endorsement granting the same driving privileges.

19 “(2) The department may issue commercial learner driver permits under this section that grant  
20 the driving privileges of a Class A commercial, Class B commercial[,] or Class C commercial driver  
21 license, subject to the requirements and restrictions [of subsections (6) and (7) of] **described in** this  
22 section.

23 “(3) An applicant for a commercial learner driver permit must be 18 years of age or older **and**  
24 **must have a valid driver license issued by the department.**

25 “(4) In addition to meeting the requirement of providing proof of legal presence under ORS  
26 807.021 and 807.040, an applicant for a commercial learner driver permit must submit valid doc-  
27 umentation, as defined by the department by rule, that the person is a citizen or permanent legal  
28 resident of the United States. The requirements of this subsection do not apply to:

29 “(a) An applicant for a limited term commercial learner driver permit issued under ORS 807.730.

30 “(b) **A person who is a citizen of a country with a Compact of Free Association with the**  
31 **United States.**

32 “(5) A commercial learner driver permit is valid for a period of one year from the date of issu-  
33 ance and is not renewable.

34 “(6) **Except as provided in subsection (7) of this section,** the holder of the commercial  
35 learner driver permit may not operate a commercial motor vehicle unless the holder has the permit  
36 in the holder’s immediate possession and is accompanied by a person who:

37 “(a) Is at least 21 years of age; [and who]

38 “(b) Holds a class of commercial driver license and endorsements that grant the driving privi-  
39 leges required to operate the vehicle[.];

40 “(c) **Has no restrictions on the person’s driving privileges that would make operation of**  
41 **the vehicle unlawful under ORS 807.010 (2);**

42 “(d) [*The accompanying person must have*] **Has** the permit holder under observation and direct  
43 supervision; and [*must be*]

44 “(e) **Is** occupying a seat beside the holder of the permit or, in the case of a commercial pas-  
45 senger vehicle, directly behind or in the first row behind the driver.

1       “(7) When taking an examination as described in ORS 807.070 (3) with an examiner em-  
2       ployed by the department, the holder of a commercial learner driver permit is not required  
3       to be accompanied by a commercial driver license holder as otherwise required under sub-  
4       section (6) of this section.

5       “[(7)] (8) The holder of a commercial learner **driver** permit may not operate:

6       “(a) Any vehicle transporting hazardous materials.

7       “(b) A tank vehicle, unless the tank is empty.

8       “(c) A commercial passenger vehicle while transporting passengers, unless the passengers are  
9       federal or state auditors or inspectors, test examiners or other trainees and there is a commercial  
10      driver license holder accompanying the permit holder as required by subsection (6) of this section.

11      “(d) A school bus while transporting passengers, unless the other passengers are federal or state  
12      auditors or inspectors, test examiners or other trainees and there is a commercial driver license  
13      holder accompanying the permit holder as required by subsection (6) of this section.

14      “(e) A commercial motor vehicle combination consisting of more than one towed vehicle.

15      “[(8)] (9) A commercial learner driver permit must contain all of the applicable information de-  
16      scribed in ORS 807.110 (1) and a prominent statement that the permit is a *[commercial learner permit*  
17      *or CLP.]* ‘**commercial learner permit**’ or ‘**CLP**.’

18      “[(9)] (10) An applicant for a commercial learner driver permit must pay the commercial learner  
19      driver permit fee established under ORS 807.370.

20      “**SECTION 5b. The amendments to ORS 807.285 by section 5a of this 2017 Act become**  
21      **operative on January 1, 2018.**

22      “**SECTION 5c.** If Senate Bill 37 becomes law, section 15, chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2017 (En-  
23      rolled Senate Bill 37), is amended to read:

24      “**Sec. 15.** (1) The amendments to ORS 807.340 by section 1, **chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2017**  
25      **(Enrolled Senate Bill 37)**, *[of this 2017 Act]* apply to driver licenses, driver permits or endorsements  
26      issued before, on or after the effective date of *[this 2017 Act]* **chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2017**  
27      **(Enrolled Senate Bill 37).**

28      “(2) The amendments to ORS 809.525 by section 2, **chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled**  
29      **Senate Bill 37)**, *[of this 2017 Act]* apply to conduct occurring on or after the effective date of *[this*  
30      *2017 Act]* **chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 37).**

31      “(3) The amendments to ORS 807.035 and 807.070 by sections 3 and 4, **chapter \_\_\_, Oregon**  
32      **Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 37)**, *[of this 2017 Act]* apply to endorsements issued on or after  
33      the effective date of *[this 2017 Act]* **chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 37).**

34      “(4) The amendments to ORS 807.040 by section 5, **chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled**  
35      **Senate Bill 37)**, *[of this 2017 Act]* apply to applications for commercial driver licenses submitted on  
36      or after the effective date of *[this 2017 Act]* **chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill**  
37      **37).**

38      “(5) The amendments to ORS 807.100 by section 6, **chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled**  
39      **Senate Bill 37)**, *[of this 2017 Act]* apply to the issuance, renewal or cancellation of commercial  
40      driving privileges that occurs on or after the effective date of *[this 2017 Act]* **chapter \_\_\_, Oregon**  
41      **Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 37).**

42      “(6) The amendments to ORS 807.031 by section 7, **chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled**  
43      **Senate Bill 37)**, *[of this 2017 Act]* apply to commercial driver licenses issued before, on or after the  
44      effective date of *[this 2017 Act]* **chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 37).**

45      “(7) The amendments to ORS 807.285 by *[section 8 of this 2017 Act]* **section 5a of this 2017 Act**

1 apply to commercial learner driver permits issued on or after the effective date of [this 2017 Act]  
2 **chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 37).**

3 “(8) The amendments to ORS 807.110 by section 11, **chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled**  
4 **Senate Bill 37)**, [of this 2017 Act] apply to licenses issued on or after the effective date of [this 2017  
5 Act] **chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 37).**

6 “(9) The amendments to ORS 807.072 by section 12, **chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled**  
7 **Senate Bill 37)**, [of this 2017 Act] apply to demonstrations waived on or after the effective date of  
8 [this 2017 Act] **chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 37).**

9 “(10) The amendments to ORS 807.018 by section 13, **chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled**  
10 **Senate Bill 37)**, [of this 2017 Act] apply to commercial driving privileges held on or after the ef-  
11 fective of [this 2017 Act] **chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 37).**

12 “(11) The amendments to ORS 807.310 by section 14, **chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled**  
13 **Senate Bill 37)**, [of this 2017 Act] apply to applicant temporary driver permits issued on or after the  
14 effective date of [this 2017 Act] **chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 37).**

15 “**SECTION 6.** ORS 807.730 is amended to read:

16 “807.730. (1) The Department of Transportation may issue or replace a limited term driver li-  
17 cense, **limited term commercial driver license**, limited term driver permit, **limited term com-**  
18 **mmercial learner driver permit** or limited term identification card only for a person who provides  
19 proof, as determined by the department by rule, that the person is legally present in the United  
20 States on a temporary basis.

21 “(2) A limited term driver license, **limited term commercial driver license** or limited term  
22 identification card is valid:

23 “(a) During the applicant’s authorized stay in the United States, but no longer than eight years  
24 from the date of issuance; or

25 “(b) If there is no definite end to the authorized stay, for a period of one year.

26 “(3) A limited term driver permit **or a limited term commercial learner driver permit** is  
27 valid:

28 “(a) During the applicant’s authorized stay in the United States, but no longer than the period  
29 of time for which a driver permit of the same type is issued by the department.

30 “(b) If there is no definite end to the authorized stay, for a period of one year but no longer than  
31 the period of time for which a driver permit of the same type is issued by the department.

32 “(4) A limited term driver license, **limited term commercial driver license**, limited term driver  
33 permit, **limited term commercial learner driver permit** or limited term identification card may  
34 be renewed only upon presentation of valid documentation, as determined by the department by rule,  
35 that the status by which the applicant qualified for the limited term driver license, **limited term**  
36 **commercial driver license**, limited term driver permit, **limited term commercial learner driver**  
37 **permit** or limited term identification card has been extended or is still in effect.

38 “(5) A limited term driver license or limited term driver permit grants the same privileges as a  
39 driver license or driver permit.

40 “(6) A limited term identification card shall bear a statement to the effect that the limited term  
41 identification card is not a license or any other grant of driving privileges to operate a motor ve-  
42 hicle and is to be used for identification purposes only.

43 “(7) **A limited term commercial driver license or limited term commercial learner driver**  
44 **permit grants the same privileges as a commercial driver license or commercial learner**  
45 **driver permit.**

1       **“(8) The department may issue a limited term commercial driver license or limited term**  
2 **commercial learner driver permit if the applicant is otherwise eligible for commercial driving**  
3 **privileges. The department may adopt rules describing eligibility requirements for limited**  
4 **term commercial driver licenses and limited term commercial learner driver permits.**

5       **“SECTION 7.** ORS 807.370 is amended to read:

6       “807.370. The following are the fees relating to the issuance and renewal of licenses, driver  
7 permits and endorsements:

8       “(1) Disability golf cart driver permit fees under ORS 807.210, as follows:

9       “(a) For issuance, \$44.

10       “(b) For renewal fee under ORS 807.210, \$32.

11       “(2) Emergency driver permit fee under ORS 807.220, \$23.50.

12       “(3) Instruction driver permit fees under ORS 807.280, as follows:

13       “(a) For issuance, \$23.50.

14       “(b) For renewal, \$23.50.

15       “(4) Commercial learner driver permit issuance fee under ORS 807.285, \$23.50.

16       “(5)(a) License issuance fee for a Class C license, \$54.

17       “(b) Fee to take the knowledge test for a Class C license, \$5.

18       “(c) Fee to take the skills test for a Class C license, \$9.

19       “(6) License issuance fee for a restricted Class C license, \$54.

20       “(7) License issuance fee for a commercial driver license, whether or not the license contains  
21 endorsements, \$75.50.

22       “(8) Test fees for a commercial driver license or permit:

23       “(a) To take the knowledge test for a Class A commercial driver license or permit, \$10.

24       “(b) To take the skills test for a Class A commercial driver license, \$70.

25       “(c) To take the knowledge test for a Class B commercial driver license or permit, \$10.

26       “(d) To take the skills test for a Class B commercial driver license, \$70.

27       “(e) To take the knowledge test for a Class C commercial driver license or permit, \$10.

28       “(f) To take the skills test for a Class C commercial driver license, \$70.

29       “(9) Notwithstanding subsection (7) of this section, for issuance of a commercial driver license  
30 of any class when the Department of Transportation accepts a certificate of competency issued un-  
31 der ORS 807.080, \$40 in addition to the fee under subsection (7) of this section.

32       “(10) Notwithstanding subsection (7) of this section, for original issuance of a school bus  
33 endorsement to a person who has a commercial driver license with a passenger endorsement:

34       “(a) \$21; or

35       “(b) \$61 if the department accepts a certificate of competency issued under ORS 807.080.

36       “(11) For a farm endorsement, \$26.

37       “(12) Test fees for the knowledge test for endorsements other than motorcycle and farm  
38 endorsements:

39       “(a) For a hazardous materials endorsement, \$10.

40       “(b) For a tank vehicle endorsement, \$10.

41       “(c) For a passenger endorsement, \$10.

42       “(d) For a double and triple trailer endorsement, \$10.

43       “(e) For a school bus endorsement, \$10.

44       “(13) Fee to take an airbrake knowledge test, \$10.

45       “(14) Fee to take an airbrake skills test to remove an airbrake restriction, \$56.

1 “(15) License renewal fee for a commercial driver license, \$55.50.  
2 “(16) License renewal fee for a Class C license, \$34.  
3 “(17) License or driver permit replacement fee under ORS 807.160, \$26.50.  
4 “(18) Original endorsement issuance fee under ORS 807.170 for a motorcycle endorsement, \$46,  
5 in addition to any fees for the endorsed license.  
6 “(19) Special student driver permit fee under ORS 807.230, \$23.50.  
7 “(20) Student Driver Training Fund eligibility fee under ORS 807.040 and 807.150, \$6.  
8 “(21) Motorcycle Safety Subaccount fee as follows:  
9 “(a) Upon original issuance of motorcycle endorsements under ORS 807.170, \$38.  
10 “(b) Upon renewal of a license with a motorcycle endorsement under ORS 807.170, \$28.  
11 “(22) Probationary driver permit application fee under ORS 807.270, \$50.  
12 “(23) Hardship driver permit application fee under ORS 807.240, \$50.  
13 “(24) Fee for reinstatement of revoked driving privileges under ORS 809.390, \$75.  
14 “(25) Fee for reinstatement of suspended driving privileges under ORS 809.380, \$75.  
15 “(26) Fee for reinstatement of right to apply for driving privileges after a delay under ORS  
16 809.280 (10) (1997 Edition), the same as the fee for reinstatement of suspended driving privileges.  
17 “(27) Fee for a special limited vision condition learner’s permit under ORS 807.359, \$13.  
18 “(28)(a) License issuance fee for a Class C limited term license, \$23.  
19 “(b) Fee to take the knowledge test for a Class C limited term license, \$5.  
20 “(c) Fee to take the skills test for a Class C limited term license, \$9.  
21 “(29) License issuance fee for a restricted Class C limited term license, \$23.  
22 “(30) License issuance fee for a limited term commercial driver license, whether or not the li-  
23 cense contains endorsements, \$45.  
24 “(31) License renewal fee for a limited term commercial driver license, \$14.  
25 “(32) License renewal fee for a Class C limited term license, \$8.  
26 “(33) Limited term license or limited term driver permit replacement fee under ORS 807.160,  
27 \$26.50.  
28 “(34) Limited term Student Driver Training Fund eligibility fee under ORS 807.040 and 807.150,  
29 \$2.  
30 “(35) **Limited term commercial learner driver permit issuance fee under ORS 807.730,**  
31 **\$23.50.**  
32 “**SECTION 8.** ORS 807.110 is amended to read:  
33 “807.110. (1) A license issued by the Department of Transportation shall contain all of the fol-  
34 lowing:  
35 “(a) The distinguishing number assigned to the person issued the license by the department.  
36 “(b) For the purpose of identification, a brief description of the person to whom the license is  
37 issued.  
38 “(c) The full legal name of the person to whom the license is issued, except that the department  
39 may limit the number of characters displayed on the license.  
40 “(d) The date of birth of the person to whom the license is issued.  
41 “(e) Except as provided for corrections officers in ORS 802.253, eligible employees in ORS  
42 802.250 or Address Confidentiality Program participants in ORS 192.846, the residence address of the  
43 person to whom the license is issued.  
44 “(f) Upon request of the person to whom the license is issued, the fact that the person is an  
45 anatomical donor.

1 “(g) Upon request of the person to whom the license is issued and presentation of proof, as de-  
2 termined by the department, the fact that the person is a veteran, as defined in ORS 408.225.

3 “(h) Upon order of the juvenile court, the fact that the person to whom the license is issued is  
4 an emancipated minor.

5 “(i) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2) of this section, a photograph described in this  
6 paragraph. A photograph required under this paragraph shall:

7 “(A) Be a full-faced, color photograph of the person to whom the license is issued;

8 “(B) Be of a size approved by the department; and

9 “(C) Be taken at the time of application for issuance of the license whether the application is  
10 for an original license, replacement of a license under ORS 807.160 or for renewal of a license under  
11 ORS 807.150, except that the department, by rule, may allow the applicant to use a photograph al-  
12 ready on file with the department.

13 “(j) The class of license issued and any endorsements granted. If the license is a commercial  
14 driver license, the words ‘commercial driver license’ or the letters ‘CDL’ shall appear on the license.

15 “(k) The signature of the person to whom the license is issued.

16 “(2) The department may issue a valid license without a photograph to an applicant:

17 “(a) Who objects on religious grounds;

18 “(b) Who objects because of the applicant’s facial disfigurement; or

19 “(c) Who is stationed outside of this state while serving in the active military service in the  
20 Armed Forces of the United States or the National Guard, and the department does not have an  
21 acceptable photograph of the applicant, as determined by the department by rule. This paragraph  
22 applies to an applicant who is renewing or replacing a license.

23 “(3) A limited term driver license **or a limited term commercial driver license** issued under  
24 ORS 807.730 shall indicate:

25 “(a) That it is a limited term driver license; and

26 “(b) The date on which the limited term driver license expires.

27 “(4) The department shall use security procedures, processes and materials in the preparation,  
28 manufacture and issuance of any license that prohibit as nearly as possible anyone’s ability to alter,  
29 counterfeit, duplicate or modify the license without ready detection. The security features used in  
30 the production of the licenses shall provide for:

31 “(a) The authentication of a genuine document in a reasonable time; and

32 “(b) The production of the license only by equipment that requires verification of the identity  
33 of the operator of the equipment before a license may be produced.

34 “**SECTION 9.** ORS 807.140 is amended to read:

35 “807.140. (1) Before the expiration of any license or a license with an endorsement under the  
36 vehicle code, the Department of Transportation shall notify the person to whom the license was is-  
37 sued of the approaching expiration. Within a reasonable time prior to the expiration date, the notice  
38 shall be mailed to the person to whom the license was issued at the address shown in the files  
39 maintained by the department.

40 “(2) The department is not required to notify the person of an approaching expiration if the  
41 person’s license has been suspended, canceled or revoked or if the person has failed to notify the  
42 department of a change of address as required under ORS 807.560.

43 “(3) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, the department is not required to notify the  
44 person of an approaching expiration if the person received a limited term driver license, **limited**  
45 **term commercial driver license**, limited term driver permit, **limited term commercial learner**



1 **driver permit** or limited term identification card under ORS 807.730 for a period of less than one  
2 year.

3 “(4) Failure to receive a notice of expiration from the department is not a defense to a charge  
4 of driving with an expired license. However, the court may dismiss the charge if the person renews  
5 the license before the scheduled court appearance.

6 “(5) The department’s responsibility to maintain records concerning notice under this section is  
7 as provided under ORS 802.210.

8 **“SECTION 10. The amendments to ORS 807.050 and 807.072 by sections 1 and 2 of this 2017**  
9 **Act become operative on January 1, 2018.**

10 **“SECTION 11. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**  
12 **on its passage.”.**

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
