

# A-Engrossed Senate Bill 5543

Ordered by the Senate June 13  
Including Senate Amendments dated June 13

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## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

**Increases and decreases certain biennial appropriations made from General Fund to Department of Human Services and Oregon Health Authority.**

**Increases and decreases limitations on expenditures for Department of Human Services and Oregon Health Authority.**

Declares emergency, effective *[July 1, 2017]* on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law appropriating moneys, limiting expenditures or otherwise adjusting appropriations or expenditure limitations, and in addition to any action by the Emergency Board, the authorized appropriations and expenditure limitations for the biennium ending June 30, 2017, for the following agencies and programs are changed by the amounts specified:**
