

Requested by Senator FERRIOLI

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 56**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “declaring an emergency” and  
2 insert “prescribing an effective date”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 29 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part**  
5 **of sections 1 to 6, chapter 97, Oregon Laws 2016.**

6 **“SECTION 2. (1) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall issue**  
7 **one or more orders providing for the use of one or more service pro-**  
8 **viders that meet the qualifications set forth in subsection (2) of this**  
9 **section for the purpose of processing and keeping records of trans-**  
10 **actions occurring between licensees, consumers and other entities or**  
11 **individuals authorized under the laws of this state to engage in the**  
12 **business of producing, processing, selling or testing marijuana items,**  
13 **as identified by the commission.**

14 **“(2) A service provider is qualified for purposes of this section if the**  
15 **business:**

16 **“(a) Is a Level 1 Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard**  
17 **(PCI DSS) validated provider;**

18 **“(b) Is certified by Europay, MasterCard and Visa (EMV);**

19 **“(c) Is capable of integrating with a minimum of 50 payment**  
20 **processors;**

21 **“(d) Is able to demonstrate that the business has made more than**

1 20 million transactions in each month during the 24-month period  
2 preceding the date on which the commission issues the order; and

3 “(e) Meets any other qualification specified in the commission’s  
4 order.

5 “SECTION 3. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the  
6 date on which the 2017 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative  
7 Assembly adjourns sine die.”.
