**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2297**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after the first semicolon delete the rest of the
2 line and line 3 and insert “amending ORS 536.021.”.

3 Delete lines 5 through 23 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 536.021 is amended to read:

5 “536.021. (1) The Water Measurement Cost Share Program Revolving Fund
6 is established separate and distinct from the General Fund. All moneys in
7 the Water Measurement Cost Share Program Revolving Fund are contin-
8 uously appropriated to the Water Resources Department for the purposes
9 described in this section.

10 “(2) The fund established in this section consists of moneys appropriated
11 by the Legislative Assembly and moneys gifted, bequested, donated or
12 granted from any person for the purpose of installing, substantially repairing
13 or replacing streamflow gauges, measuring devices or headgates with meas-
14 uring devices.

15 “(3) The department may use the moneys in the fund to contribute up to
16 75 percent of the moneys needed to install, substantially repair or replace a
17 streamflow gauge, measuring device or headgate with a measuring device on
18 authorized diversions [*on the waters of this state*] **or points of appropriation**
19 where the gauge, measuring device or headgate will be used to protect in-
20 stream flow or **existing water rights, measure ground water use or** [*to*]
21 monitor water rights and streamflow.

1 “(4) The department may receive funds from, and may enter into agree-
2 ments or contracts with, any person for the purpose of implementing the
3 Water Measurement Cost Share Program Revolving Fund.

4 “(5) The department shall prioritize the expenditure of moneys from the
5 fund for streamflow gauges, measuring devices and headgates with measuring
6 devices in the following descending order:

7 “(a) Installation.

8 “(b) Replacement.

9 “(c) Substantial repair.”.

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
