**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2919**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “facilities” insert “; amending
2 ORS 624.010”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 27 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 624.010 is amended to read:

5 “624.010. As used in ORS 624.010 to 624.121, unless the context requires
6 otherwise:

7 “(1) ‘Authority’ means the Oregon Health Authority.

8 “(2) ‘Bed and breakfast facility’ means any establishment located in a
9 structure designed for a single family residence and structures appurtenant
10 thereto, regardless of whether the owner or operator of the establishment
11 resides in any of the structures, that:

12 “(a) Has more than two rooms for rent on a daily basis to the public; and

13 “(b) Offers meal service as provided in ORS 624.046 as part of the cost
14 of the room.

15 “(3) ‘Director’ means the Director of the Oregon Health Authority.

16 “(4) ‘Intermittent temporary restaurant’ means an establishment:

17 “(a) That operates temporarily at a specific location in connection with
18 multiple public gatherings, entertainment events, food product promotions
19 or other events, at least two of which are arranged for by different oversight
20 organizations; and

21 “(b) Where food is prepared or served for consumption by the public.

1 “(5) ‘Limited service restaurant’ means a restaurant serving only individ-
2 ually portioned prepackaged foods prepared from an approved source by a
3 commercial processor and nonperishable beverages.

4 “(6) ‘Operational review’ means the examination of a plan of operation for
5 an establishment in order to ensure that the proposed operation conforms
6 with applicable sanitation standards.

7 “(7) ‘Oversight organization’ means an entity responsible for organizing,
8 managing or otherwise arranging for a public gathering, entertainment
9 event, food product promotion or other event, including but not limited to
10 ensuring the availability of water, sewer and sanitation services.

11 “(8) ‘Person’ means a person as defined in ORS 174.100, a public body as
12 defined in ORS 174.109, the Oregon Health and Science University or the
13 Oregon State Bar.

14 “(9) ‘Restaurant,’ except as provided in subsection [(9)] (10) of this sec-
15 tion, means [*an establishment*]:

16 “(a) **An establishment:**

17 “[*a*] (A) Where food or drink is prepared for consumption by the public;

18 “[*b*] (B) Where the public obtains food or drink so prepared in form or
19 quantity consumable then and there, whether or not it is consumed within
20 the confines of the premises where prepared; or

21 “[*c*] (C) That prepares food or drink in consumable form for service
22 outside the premises where prepared[.]; or

23 “(b) **A facility providing food services at a senior community resi-
24 dence.**

25 “(10) ‘Restaurant’ does not mean a railroad dining car, bed and breakfast
26 facility, intermittent temporary restaurant, seasonal temporary restaurant
27 or single-event temporary restaurant.

28 “(11) ‘Seasonal temporary restaurant’ means an establishment:

29 “(a) That operates at a specific location in connection with multiple
30 public gatherings, entertainment events, food product promotions or other

1 events that are arranged for by the same oversight organization; and
2 “(b) Where food is prepared or served for consumption by the public.
3 **“(12) ‘Senior community residence’:**
4 **“(a) Means a facility that:**
5 **“(A) Provides residential accommodations for six or more house-**
6 **holds; and**
7 **“(B) Has a majority of residents who are 55 years of age or older.**
8 **“(b) Does not include a facility:**
9 **“(A) Routinely providing residents with care, treatment or coun-**
10 **seling to meet health care, mental health, dependency or disability**
11 **needs; or**
12 **“(B) Occupied as transient lodging or under a week-to-week**
13 **tenancy, both as defined in ORS 90.100.**
14 “[12] **(13) ‘Single-event temporary restaurant’ means an establishment:**
15 **“(a) That operates in connection with a single public gathering, enter-**
16 **tainment event, food product promotion or other event; and**
17 **“(b) Where food is prepared or served for consumption by the public.”.**
