**SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires [*Office of Emergency Management*] **State Fire Marshal** to issue grants to sheriffs' offices of Multnomah County and Hood River County for expenses related to wildfire recovery, mitigation and preparedness.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to [*office*] **State Fire Marshal**.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

2 Relating to wildfires; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. On or before April 30, 2018, the State Fire Marshal shall issue grants to the**  
5 **sheriffs' offices of Multnomah County and Hood River County for expenses related to wildfire**  
6 **recovery, mitigation and preparedness, which may include, without limitation:**

7 (1) **Equipment and training relating to prevention, assessment and mitigation of wildfires;**

8 (2) **Equipment and training, including poles, helmets and helmet lamps, for use in search**  
9 **and rescue and other fire-related operations; and**

10 (3) **Wildfire first responder training.**

11 **SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
12 **ated to the State Fire Marshal, for the biennium ending June 30, 2019, out of the General**  
13 **Fund, the amount of \$151,000, which may be expended for the purposes described in section**  
14 **1 of this 2018 Act.**

15 **SECTION 3. This 2018 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
16 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2018 Act takes effect**  
17 **on its passage.**
