SB 696

Increases amount of insurance policy that may be required by county governing body to approve permit for outdoor mass gathering.

SB 775 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/14/2019 AGENDA: Requires agencies of state government to use Department of State Police for purposes of requesting criminal records checks relating to employment by agency.

SB 810

Modifies definition of "vulnerable user of a public way" to include persons operating or riding on moped or motorcycle.

SB 977 A

Repeals provisions relating to undertaking of justice of the peace.

SB 474

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/14/2019 AGENDA: Modifies length of time of parental desertion or abandonment of child resulting in forfeiture of parent's intestate share of child's estate and parent's interest in property transferred from child to parent by transfer on death deed.

SB 638 A

Requires research facilities that use dogs or cats for laboratory research to offer dogs or cats no longer used for research for adoption prior to euthanization .

SB 759

Provides that auction company has lien on motor vehicle that auction company possesses and stored on premises that auction company owns or controls.

SB 797 A

Provides exception to offense of illegal consignment practices.

SB 1008 A

Requires court to include in judgment document age of defendant at time of committing offense if defendant is sentenced to term of incarceration and physical custody of defendant is related to age of defendant at time of committing offense.
