Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 24 A
Modifies procedures related to criminal defendants lacking fitness to proceed.
- SB 25 A
Directs public bodies, and private medical providers in possession of relevant records, to comply, within specified time period, with court order for release of records to state mental hospital or other facility for purposes of forensic evaluation.
- SB 184 A
Authorizes court to initiate commitment proceedings for extremely dangerous person with mental illness if court determines that there is no substantial probability that defendant will gain or regain fitness to proceed.
- SB 373 A
Expands public records law references that govern confidentiality of records maintained by Psychiatric Security Review Board.
- SB 375 A
Directs court to inform defendant of potential commitment or conditional discharge prior to accepting plea of guilty except for insanity.

Work Session

- SB 495 A
Prohibits use of dog to extract inmate from cell in correctional facilities .
- SB 498 A
Prohibits Department of Corrections from entering into contract with inmate telephone services provider that authorizes department to receive fee or commission other than reimbursement for expenses.
- SB 1011 A
Provides that obligee spouse's conviction for attempted murder or conspiracy to commit murder of obligor spouse is change of circumstances for purposes of spousal support modification.

Note change: SB 24 A, SB 25 A, SB 184 A, SB 373 A, 375 A changed to public hearings and work sessions.
