SB 1021 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Department of Transportation to add auxiliary lane on portion of Interstate 5 near City of Wilsonville and make seismic improvements to Boone Bridge.

Public Hearing

HB 3209 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Authorizes issuance of general obligation bonds for Interstate 205: Stafford Road to State Highway 213 Project.

Work Session

HB 2112
Requires Department of Transportation to study development of uniform standards for speed bump height and markings.

SB 558
Authorizes city to designate speed for highway under city's jurisdiction that is five miles per hour lower than statutory speed when highway is located in residence district and highway is not arterial highway.

SB 666
Increases fee for Pacific Wonderland registration plates.

SB 1033
Provides that registered owner may request that registration card issued for vehicle include information that owner, or person operating vehicle, may be deaf or hard of hearing.

SB 1044
Establishes goals that promote zero-emission vehicle use and requires entities of executive department to promote zero-emission vehicle use.
