

Hello,

My name is Katie Bonner. I am the mother to three beautiful children. What I want most for my babies is to live their healthiest, best life. I study each of them and see the difference in their quirks, senses of humor, appetites, hobbies. My job as their mother is to oversee their growth and development so that they will become healthy contributing members of society. When my decision-making parental **RIGHTS** are taken away, like HB 3063 threatens to do, I cannot fulfill my duties. I cannot study and apply what I deem best for each of these unique individuals. What makes one thrive is not necessarily the same as the other, whether we are looking at learning styles or vaccinations.

My daughter's immune system works great. One could say it even over functions. When she receives her vaccinations, it kicks her body into hyperdrive to learn about whatever virus is being injected and create antibodies so she never has to fight the real disease. The problem is that she has underlying predispositions for multiple autoimmune diseases. Sending her immune system into hyperdrive not only triggers it to combat the foreign virus, but also tricks it into attacking itself. Had I not been a diligent parent, I would not know that my child had autoimmune conditions with the potential to be triggered by vaccinations. Other parents have the **RIGHT** to know how their child could potentially be **HARMED**. Parents should be able to make decisions regarding their children based on their own research, religious beliefs, ideologies and privacy. Supporting HB3063 goes against what this country was founded on: protection from an overstepping government.
